Dear Sir:

Pursuant to Section 2.933 of the rules, Cisco systems authorizes LXE to apply under their own grantee identification of equipment to Cisco Systems Model 4800 that bears the FCC ID: LDK102038. The Cisco model was originally certified by the commission under the manufacturer Aironet, and most recently went through a grantee change on 3/20/2000 as a result of Aironet being bought by Cisco Systems.

The LXE variant will not modified in any way and is identical physically and electrically. The device will be known as 480631-4310 and will bear the FCC ID: KDZ480631-4310.

Cisco Systems will continue to market their device under the model number and FCC ID for which it is certified.

Per the request filed earlier the confidential information must remain in the control of Cisco Systems and not LXE.
