In response to your inquiry, I have prepared the following reply:

As a result of the tightened RF exposure requirements, all manuals are currently under revision to include the appropriate User Instructions to ensure RF safety to the operator and general population. Draft copies are not yet available, however the following statements are included prominently within the manuals.

For all hand-held only terminals

Caution 	<i>This radio-frequency device is intended for hand-held operation only. Except for the hands, a minimum separation distance of at least 20cm from the users body should be maintained during transmission. Use of this device not consistent with these instructions can increase the risk of excessive RF exposure.</i>
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For portable host devices that can be used with the hip-flip accessory:

Caution 	<i>This device is intended to transmit RF energy. When operating this device with the Hip-Flip accessory, care should be taken to ensure it is used in accordance with the users instructions. Use of this device in a manner not consistent with these instructions can increases the risk of excessive RF exposure.</i>
