
## Clean the litter box


Complete the following steps every few weeks to keep your litter box clean and raking reliably:






Lift the front of the litter box and remove the used litter tray.

**Important:** See the customer care guide for safety instructions related to cat litter waste and toxoplasmosis



Remove the privacy cover.





Open the rake covers.

Release the rake by rotating the rake clips toward the back of the litter box.









Lift the rake straight up and out of the litter box frame.

Pull straight up on the waste trap cover to remove it.

Wash the rake and waste trap cover with warm soapy water

and then dry thoroughly.


of the litter box frame. Make sure the sensors inside the litter box frame are clean and unobstructed.

**Important:** Do not use bleach or chemicals to clean; the odor may repel your cat.


Using a cloth or sponge, mild soap, and water, wipe all surfaces

Thoroughly dry all parts.









Once all litter box parts are dry, reassemble the litter box.


Replace the waste trap cover by inserting the posts on the underside of the waste trap cover into the notches inside the front of the litter box frame.

Replace the rake.


Secure the rake it by rotating the rake clips toward the front of the litter box. Close the rake covers.







Install a new litter tray.



Replace the privacy cover and plug the litter box back in.
