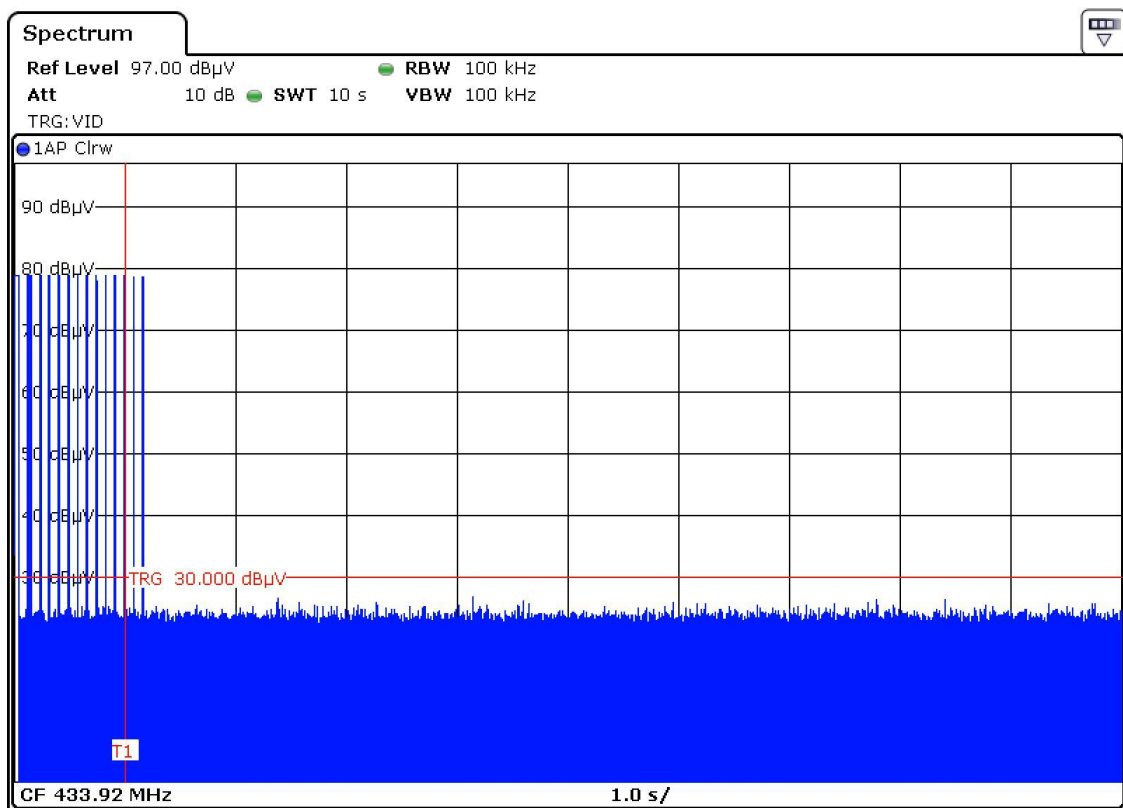

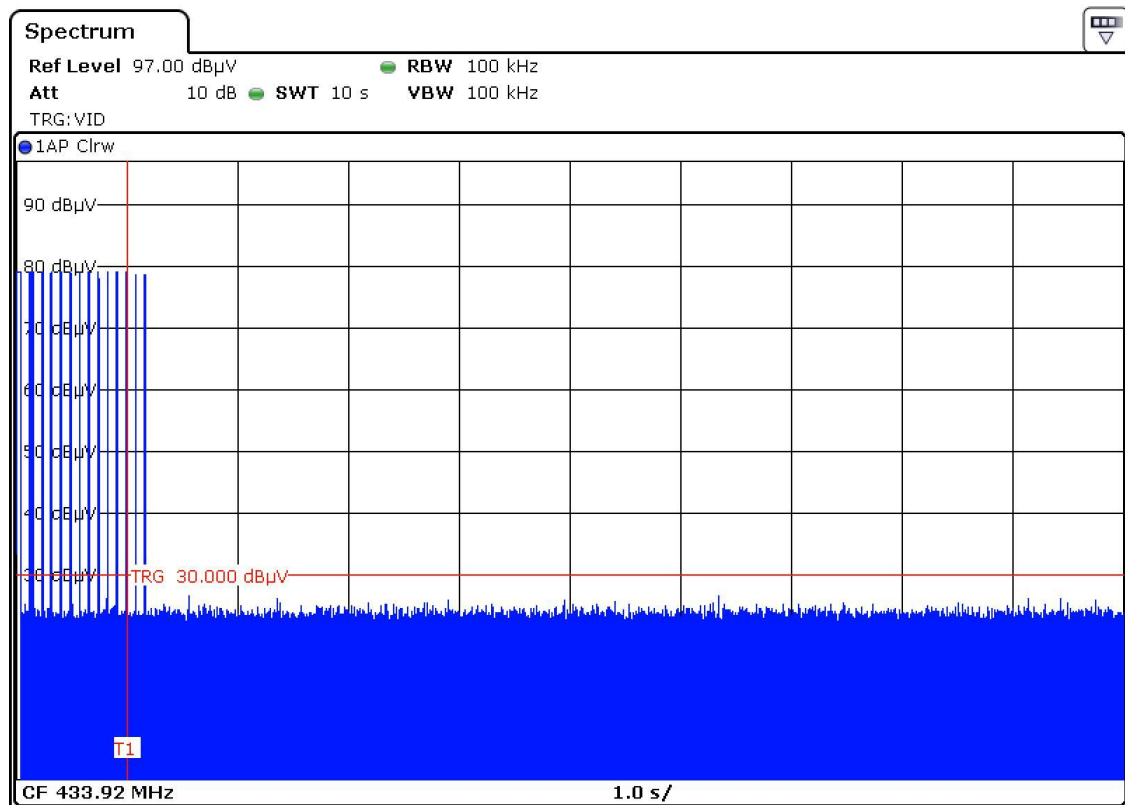
Periodic Operation Characteristics

(1) A manually operated transmitter shall employ a switch that will automatically deactivate the transmitter within not more than 5 seconds of being released.

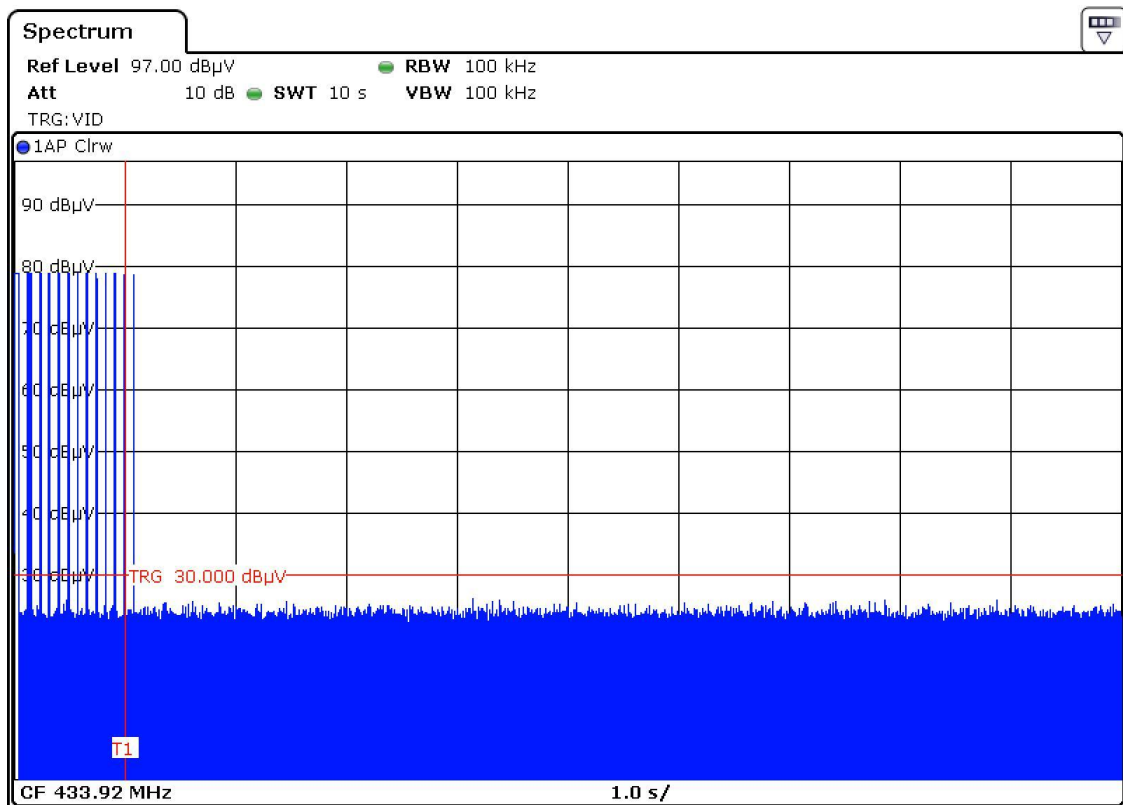
(Open button)



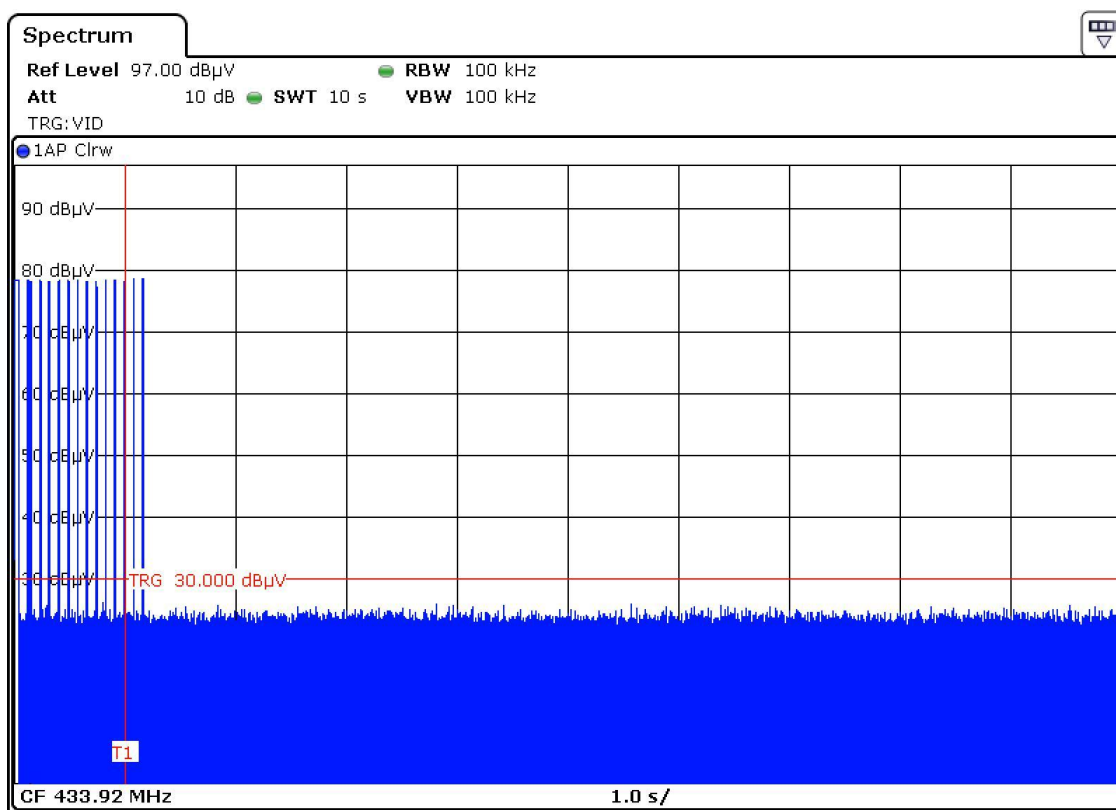
(Close button)



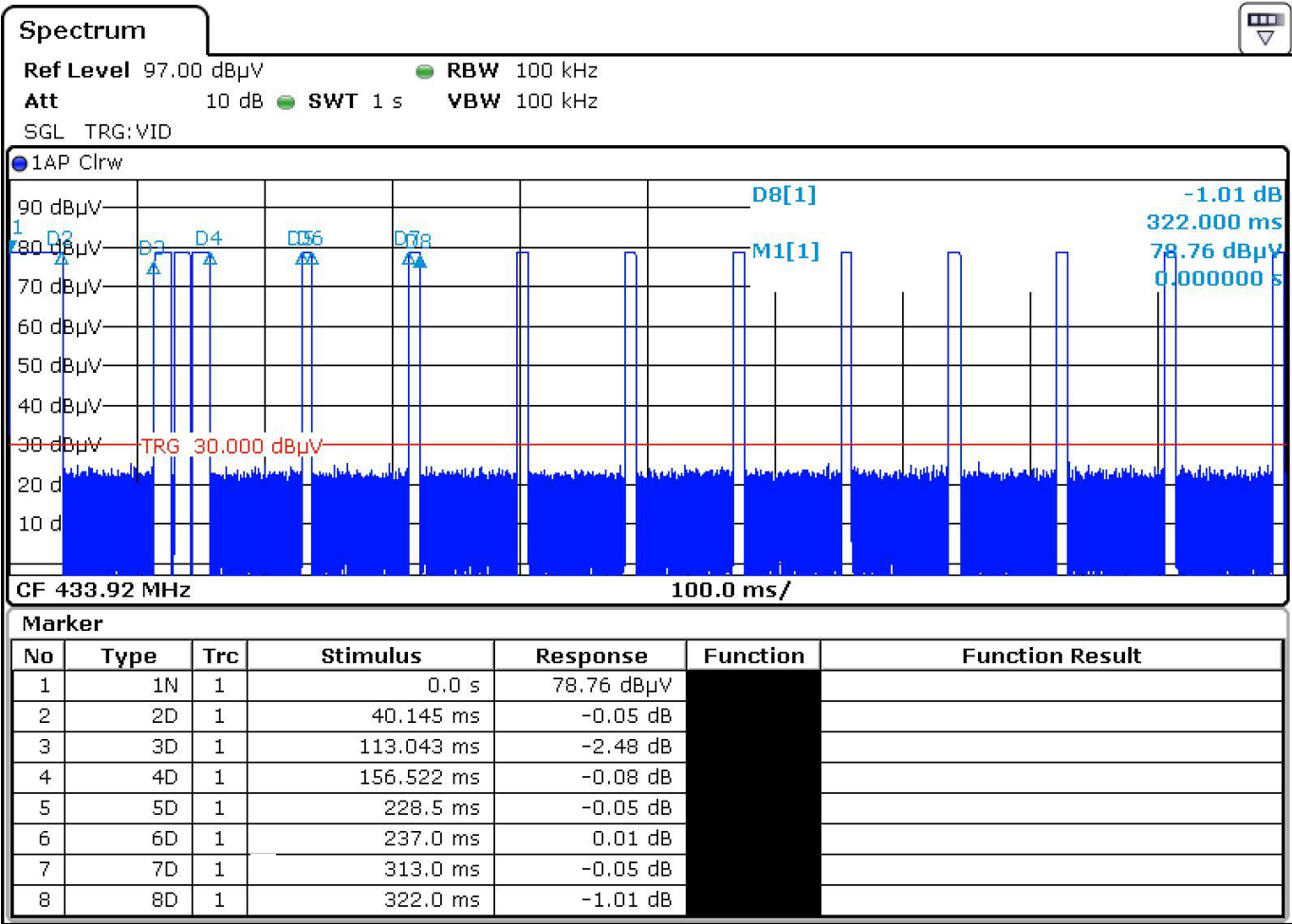
(Panic button)

Worst case transmission time in any 100 ms time window, (for all buttons nearly the same)



The measured worst case duration for a single pulse transmission in any 100 ms time window is 43.479 ms.

Maximum transmitting duration in every 100ms period: 43.479 ms

Averaging factor = $20 \cdot \log(43.479/100) = -7.2 \text{ dB}$
