Pursuant to paragraph §2.1043 of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R.) herewith we file an application for Modification/Permissive Change for the following products:

FCC ID: ***KWCTX7***


Title/Model: ***Phonak EasyLink SX***

The above mentioned product was certificated under 47 CFR Part 95 Subpart G with Grant of Certification issued on November 24, 2005. The equipment is operated at frequencies 216 – 217 MHz and is used as assistive listening devices for hearing impaired persons or as assistive listening devices for hearing impaired children in educational institutes. After certifying the equipment under Part 95 Subpart G, we were faced with the problem that the number of available channels under this part was far from enough for providing a normal teaching process in the special schools for hearing impaired children. Therefore, we would like to add Part 74 Subpart H to the existing grant, under which our equipment could be operated as non-broadcast auxiliary transmitters working additionally at frequencies 214 – 216 MHz. This way without any modification or changes in the equipment we would be able to provide the necessary number of channels for the schools for hearing impaired children and help them to organize their normal teaching process.

Although we don't make any modification or permissive change, we are filing this application based on the response to our inquiry to FCC (Tracking Number 920161) in which it was said, that adding a Rule Part to an existing Grant of Certification requires a filing for Modification/Permissive Change.
