The following addresses the comment on your **Correspondence Reference # 28602**, dated March 10, 2005.

The Ruggedized holster is made of a rigid material designed to allow the BlackBerry handheld to slide in only one way, and that is with the keyboard side facing the user (facing the belt-clip) while in the holster. This positioning has the benefit of protecting the keypad and the large LCD from damage.
