- Controller is powered by 4 x 1.5V "AA" size batteries.




CONTROLLER










OPERATING THE PLAYSET



THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

TROUBLE SHOOTING:

If vehicle does not operate properly, try the following:

- Be certain that the antenna of the controller extends the maximum length.
- Radio interference can cause your car to react strangely.
- Try fresh alkaline batteries in the vehicle and controller.
- Check the polarity of the batteries in the vehicle and controller.
- Turn vehicle switch OFF and ON.

NOTE:

- Warning! Use under the direct supervision of an adult.
- Do not play with vehicle in the street.
- Do not play vehicle over mud, water, snow or sand.
- Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from the tires while the vehicle is switched on.
- Another vehicle operating at the same frequency can disrupt the control of the vehicle.
- CB's, cellular phones, two way radios, other transmitting devices and high voltage wires may cause interference with operation.
- Your vehicle can sometimes cause interference with television or radio reception. Move to another area if you notice this occurrence.
- Clean the vehicle with a damp cloth.



INSTRUCTION MANUAL



IMPORTANT

GENERAL:

- A screwdriver is not a toy.
- Do not give the screwdriver to children.
- When the vehicle slows down or does not operate properly, change the

BATTERY:

- Switch the toy to the "off" position before inserting
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Do not mix old and new batteries together.
- Do not mix different types of batteries. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are
