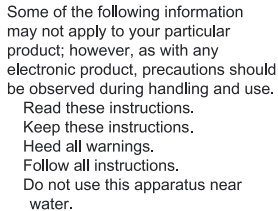




# USER MANUAL

**Precautions for the unit**

- Do not use the unit immediately after transportation from a cold place to a warm place; condensation problems may result.
- Do not store the unit near fire, places with high temperature or in direct sunlight. Exposure to direct sunlight or extreme heat (such as inside a parked car) may cause damage or malfunction.
- Clean the unit with a soft cloth or a damp chamois leather. Never use solvents.
- The unit must only be opened by qualified personnel.

This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to Part 15 of FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation. This equipment generates, uses, and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful

- (1) PAIR Button**
  - Press and hold for 3 seconds to activate pairing mode
- (2) PAIR Indicator**
  - Fast flash: ready for pairing
  - Very slow flash: in Standby mode
  - Slow flash: reconnecting to the most recently connected device
  - Solid blue: Bluetooth connection established
- (3) LINE IN**
  - 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack
- (4) DC IN**
- (5) Charging Indicator**
  - Red : charging
  - O ff: battery full
- (6) ON/OFF Switch**

2. The **PAIR Indicator** begins blinking. This indicates that the EBT-00201 is attempting to reconnect to a previously paired device.  
After a few seconds the **PAIR Indicator begins blinking rapidly**. This indicates that the EBT-00201 is now ready to pair.
3. While the EBT-00201 is in pairing mode, select IFByCLN from the list of Bluetooth devices of your phone.
4. If your phone asks for a password/pin code, enter 0000 and press **OK**.

5. Upon successful pairing, the EBT-00201 will beep once. It is now ready to use with your phone.

When you turn it on, the EBT-00201 reconnects automatically with the last paired device. When you leave the Bluetooth operating range, with the EBT-00201 turned ON, it disconnects. When you come back into the Bluetooth operating range, press the **PAIR** button to reconnect the last paired device. The EBT-00201 will beep once it has been successfully repaired.

If your device has not been connected for an extended period of time, it will enter standby to preserve battery life. In standby mode, the Pair LED indicator will blink slowly. From standby, quickly press the **PAIR** button to reconnect to the last connected device, or press and hold **PAIR** to initiate pairing. The **PAIR Indicator** will blink rapidly, and the speaker will be ready to receive a connection.

1. Go to your phone's music player and play a track by pressing "Play". If the EBT-00201 is connected, the music will be heard directly in the speaker. See your phone manual if needed.
2. For adjusting volume and controlling audio playback, please use the controls on your music player directly.

1. Plug one end of the supplied audio cable into the **LINE IN** and the other end into the output of your music player.
2. Press "Play" on your music player to stream music directly via the EBT-00201.
3. For adjusting volume and controlling audio playback, please use the controls on your music player directly.
