Widgets

To add a widget, press and hold anywhere on the home screen, and select the "Widgets" option.

Notifications and Quick Settings

Notifications panel

Swipe down from the top edge of the screen to display the Notifications panel where you can browse and reply to your emails, check software updates, reminders and more.

Quick Settings panel

Swipe down **twice** from the top edge of the screen to expand and access the Quick Settings panel, where you can easily enable/disable Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, Airplane mode and other settings.

Connecting

Wi-Fi and Bluetooth

To enable/disable Wi-Fi or Bluetooth, simply tap the icons on the Quick Settings panel as shown below.

To access more settings options, select the icon.

Expanding the storage

Inserting a Micro SD card
The tablet supports Micro SD cards up to 64GB (not included).

To install a Micro SD card into the tablet, carefully insert the card as shown below into the card slot until it clicks and locks into place.

To remove the Micro SD card, gently press it inward to eject.

Transferring files

- Connect the tablet to the computer using the included USB charging cable as shown below.
- Tap the "USB for charging" notification on the tablet screen.
- Select "File transfers".
- The internal storage of the tablet will appear on your PC.

Reset

If the tablet malfunctions or freezes, you can use the reset button to restart it.

To reset the tablet, take a metal pin (such as the end of a paper clip) and gently push the recessed reset button on the side of the tablet as shown below.

The tablet will restart.
