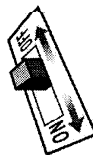

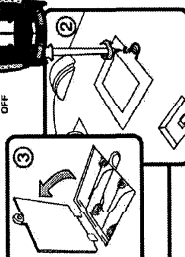

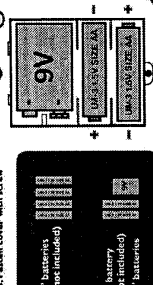
VEHICLE

3. Fasten cover with screw.

1. Remove cover life cover.
2. Insert 2 "AA" and 1 "9V" alkaline batteries.
3. Fasten cover with screw.



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
