- 1) Please submit a block diagram as per FCC Part 2, Section 2.1033(b)(5).
- 2) The sample FCC Label submitted is not sufficient. It must read "FCC ID: MKYMRXF102RX", and not "FCC: MKYMRXF102RX".
- 3) According to section 4.1 of the test report, the device under test was connected to a main module and several cables were attached to its terminal blocks. On the test setup photos; however, it appears that the unit was tested as a stand alone unit. Also, under section 4.1.1, it is stated that there were no cables. Please explain.
