

We, **ASUSTek COMPUTER INC.** hereby request a Class II Permissive Change.

Change:

1. This ID: MSQBE201NG has done the change of ID from Intel's ID: PD9BE201NG and would like to do the C2PC to establish conditions based on modular stand-alone SAR evaluation to establish minimum antenna to user separation distance (5mm, 8mm and 11mm) at a maximum SAR value $<0.8\text{W/kg}(1\text{g})$ for mixed mobile/portable conditions according to KDB 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v05 and KDB 616217 D04 for Laptop and Tablets v01r02.
2. And this C2PC is based on Intel's ID: PD9BE201NG (Grant date: 05-15-2024 for DSS, DTS, 6CD and NII grant) and Intel's report (SAR reports: 231109-06.TR02 and 231109-06.TR09 for 5mm/231109-06.TR03 and 231109-06.TR11 for 8mm/231109-06.TR01 and 231109-06.TR07 for 11mm).
3. The security mechanism implement that requires in section II of KDB 594280 D02 is unchanged and the same as it reports to the FCC at the initial certification.
