

CLASS II PERMISSIVE CHANGE Modified September 24, 2003

Mr. Tim Johnson:

I want to market an EAS decoder only under the existing Grant of Certification and FCC ID number as my certified EAS encoder-decoder FCC ID: MVZEAS1. This is permissible under 47 CFR 2.1043 (b)(2). *Changes to Certified Equipment*.

I stopped by the FCC lab on September 15 and discussed this with Mr. Rich Farina who advised me that if I stripped out the parts that are only required for the encoder that I would have to go through the certification process. However, if I left all the parts on the board and used the same cabinet I would only have to go through the notification process for a Class II Permissive Change.

The Class II permissive change will entail removing the lines of code that permit the unit to generate the FSK header Codes and the dual tone attention signal required for forwarding EAS messages. The same circuit board will be used with all of the parts placed on the board as in the certified EAS encoder-decoder. The board will be installed in the same cabinet as the certified EAS encoder-decoder.

The environmental testing of the decoder will not be required and the unintended RF conduction and radiation out of the unit will not change since it will be the same cabinet with identical parts installed.

I hope this is enough of an explanation of the only changes that will take place between the encoder-decoder and the decoder only.
