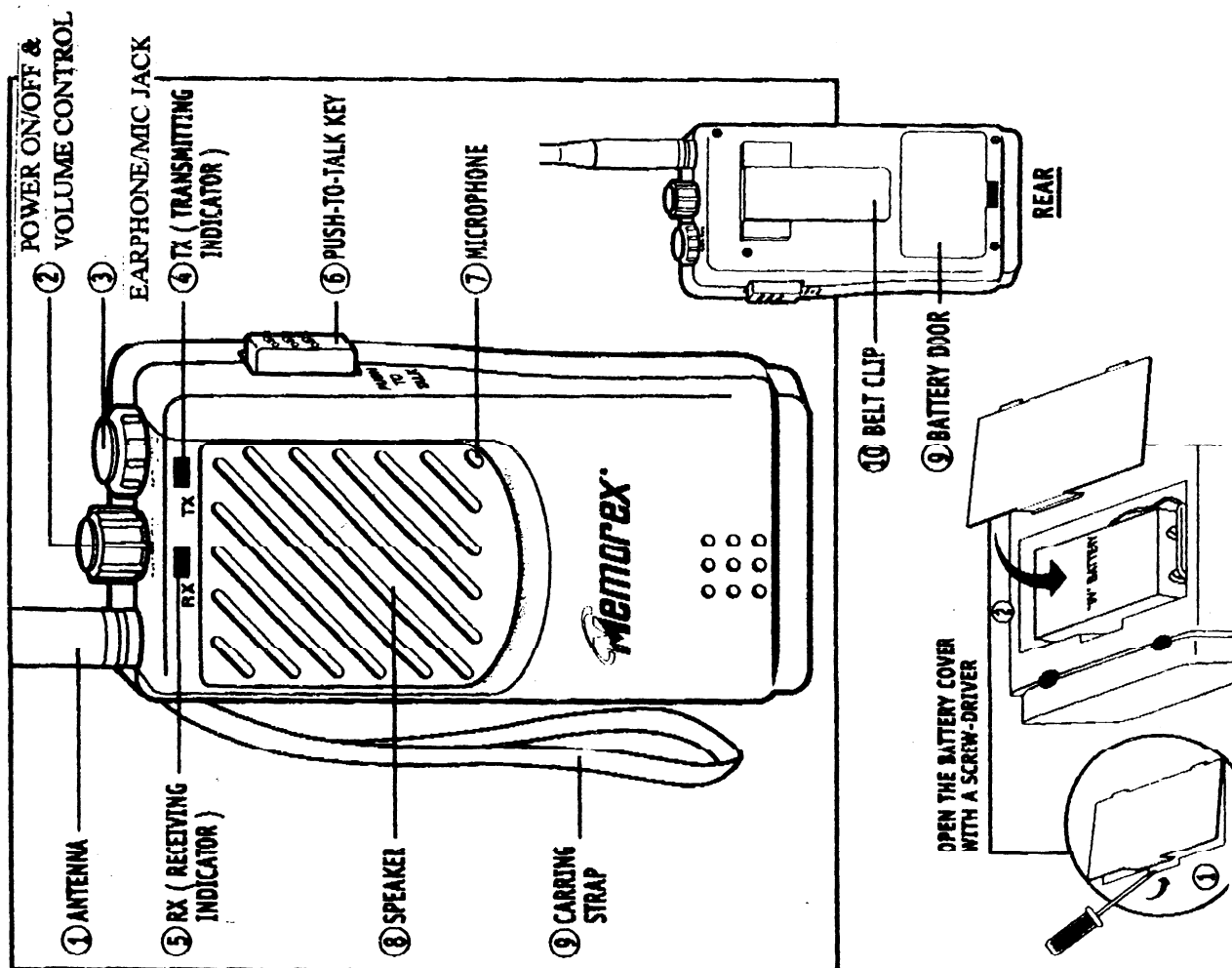


BATTERY INSTALLATION



BATTERY INSTALLATION

Each unit uses one 9V battery, which is not included with unit.

To insert battery: 1) open the battery door with a screw driver as in Fig.1

2) insert the battery and replace the battery door

The life span of batteries varies with the types of batteries and conditions under which the unit is used. Alkaline batteries are recommended for longer operating hours. Change batteries when there is a significant drop in effective range or quality of transmission.

POWER ON/OFF

The power is ON when you turn Power ON/OFF Volume control key and green light indicator is lighted (RX).

The power is OFF when you turn the Power ON/OFF Volume key and green light indicator is not lighted.

HOW TO TRANSMIT and RECEIVE

Press and hold PUSH TO TALK key and speak clearly into the microphone. The red light(TX), lights "on" during transmission. Release the PUSH TO TALK when finished so that incoming voice be heard, & green light(RX) is lighted.

RX light indicator represents "receiving signal"

TX light indicator represents "transmitting signal"
