

## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

**⚠ WARNING!** Operation of this device must always be supervised by an adult. Do not allow children access to the interior of this device and do not permit them to handle any cables.

- Do not use this device in wet or dusty environments, under direct sunlight, or in extremely hot or cold conditions. Keep away from sources of heat.

- To prevent electric shock, keep this device away from water. Do not attempt to disassemble the device. Do not remove the battery.

- Do not place heavy objects on the device. Do not drop the device. Do not apply pressure or excessive force to it.

- Do not touch the screen with any sharp or pointed objects such as knives, scissors, needles, or pencils.

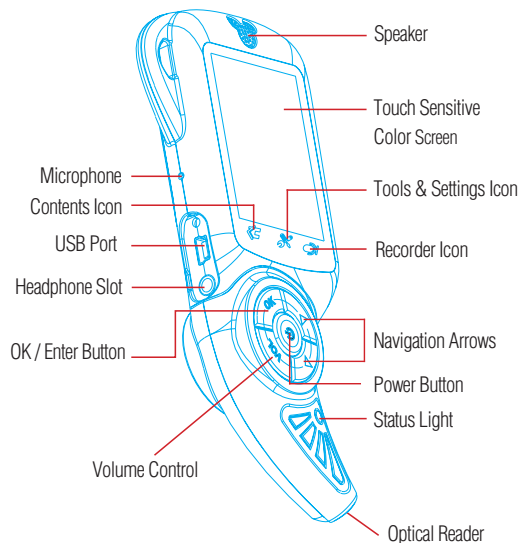
- For your own safety, do not attempt to open the device case or to make alterations. Do not paint the device or put stickers on it.

- Prevent data loss! When connecting the device to a personal computer via a USB port to charge it, do not remove or modify the files stored inside the device. Any attempt to do so could damage the contents of the device or its system folders and prevent its proper functioning. The manufacturer may not be held liable for damage and/or data loss caused by improper use of this device.

- Use only the accessories supplied with your device. Use only with the recommended transformer. Power adapters, transformers and other accessories are not toys!

- When using ports on the device, connect cables and sockets according to the usage information. Never force a connector into a port. If you need to force a connector into a port, that generally means they do not match.

- Connect the device to a power outlet using a USB cable and a USB power adapter (not supplied) to charge it. Alternatively, connect the device directly to a USB port on



your computer (not an external keyboard) using a USB cable.

- The battery may warm up while charging. This is normal. Do not cover the device while charging and allow good ventilation to the charger.

- Before cleaning the device, turn it off and disconnect from the battery charger. Clean the outside of your device with a soft cloth. Exercise caution not to scratch the screen. Do not spray glass cleaner (or other liquid) directly onto the screen.

- Actual device may differ from the picture(s) in the User's Manual. The properties offered may differ depending on the software version and the contents. Device properties may be subject to change at any time.

## BATTERY NOTICE

- Install batteries correctly observing the polarity (+, -) signs.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged by adults.

- Always remove exhausted batteries from the device.

- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

- Regularly examine the transformer or the battery charger for any damage to their cord, plug, enclosure and other parts. In case of damage to any part of the device, do not use until the damage has been repaired.

1. Make sure the device is turned off.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the device and open it.
3. Install the battery.
4. Replace the cover.

4. Replace the cover.

## GETTING STARTED

Before first use, remove the protective film covering the screen. If left on the screen, touch screen response sensitivity will decrease.

- **To Turn On:** Hold the Power button down for 1–2 seconds until the Contents screen appears.

- **To Turn Off:** Hold the Power button down for 1–2 seconds until the Goodbye screen appears.

- **To Go Back to the Contents Screen:** Press the Power button once until the Contents screen appears.

- **Navigation Arrows:** Use the left and right arrow buttons to navigate through selected features. For example,

arrows may be used to browse up and down through menu options, or to move right and left while playing certain games.

- **Touch Screen:** When you touch a menu item on the screen, it becomes active. When you touch the same menu item again, your selection is confirmed.

- **OK Button:** Use this button to confirm your menu selection and move on to the next step. Alternatively, you may confirm your selection using the touch screen.

- **Status Light:** When the device is turned on and ready, the status light flashes.

- **Optical Reader:** When placed on an image or text in the printed book, the Optical Reader plays the corresponding video, audio, games, or images.

- **USB Port:** Use this port to connect your device to a personal computer using a USB cable, or to a wall-mounted socket using a USB power adapter to charge it. USB port connection may be used for data transfer.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

There are 3 icons on the blue border of the touch screen. Use the icons to access Contents, Tools & Settings, and Recorder functions directly. Alternatively, you may access these functions by using the keypad.

- **Contents:** Select to view existing content stored in the device.

- **Optical Reader Function:** Select any content (book) from the Contents screen. Once you confirm your selection, the cover of the selected book will appear on the screen. At this stage, the device is ready.

Place the optical reader close to any text or image area in the printed book. Hold it in position for about half a second. During normal function, the status light will flash.

- **Tools & Settings:** Select this option to access Tools, Settings and Wireless functions.

## Tools:

- **Calculator:** Select to access different functions. The Calculator can be accessed from the touch screen. Press the Power button to quit.

- **Digital Dice:** Use the dice to play some of the games that can be accessed through your device. Touch the screen to roll the dice.

- **Settings:** Use this to change the settings for the Touch Screen, Background Light and/or Volume.

- **Recorder:** You can record sounds with the internal microphone on your device.

- **Rec:** Press this button to start recording. A beep tone confirms that the recording has started.

- **Play:** Press this button to listen to recordings.

- **Pause:** Press this button to pause the recording.

- **Stop:** Press this button to stop the recording.

- **Delete:** Press this button to delete the selected sound file.

- **Wireless (Only For The Wireless Models!):** Refer to the User's Manual for the Wireless TV Box unit for information about connecting your device to a TV set.
