

Interactive Hand Puppet Set[™] Instructions:



WARNING:

- Never use the Bobbie & Friends® Interactive Hand Puppet Set[™] while driving or during any sporting activities as it may lead to accidents causing injuries.
- Turn the Bobbie & Friends® Interactive Hand Puppet Set[™] off in an aircraft or any facility where posted notices restrict the use of radios or cellular telephones. Hospitals or health care facilities may be using equipment that is sensitive to RF energy.
- Never Use the Bobbie & Friends® Interactive Hand Puppet Set[™] where personal medical devices such as pacemakers or hearing aids are in use. Turn the Interactive Hand Puppet Set™ off immediately if there is any reason to suspect that interference is taking place.


Your Bobbie & Friends® Interactive Hand Puppet Set™ will achieve the maximum operating range when communicating in flat open areas with no walls, trees or buildings to obstruct the signal. Under the ideal conditions, you may achieve range up to a 10-meter

The following conditions tend to reduce the range.

- There are large obstructions such as walls, buildings, trees, vehicles, hills etc. between radios.
- The batteries are running low.

Battery Installation:

1.Open the Magic Tape at the back of Bobbie's /Bobo's Head and locate the battery compartment. (See Fig. 1)



2. Use a Phillips Screwdriver (not included) to unscrew and remove the battery compartment door.



3. Install 3 X AAA (1.5V) alkaline batteries in the battery compartment of Bobbie/ Bobo. Be careful to align the positive (+) and negative (-) polarities with the corresponding markings inside the battery compartment. (See Fig. 3)





- 4. Reinstall the battery door and tighten the screw.
- 5. Place the battery compartment back into Bobbie's/ Bobo's head and seal the magic tape.

Important Battery Information:

- In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:
- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries safely. Do not dispose of product in a fire. The battery inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as





Getting Started – Initial Setup 1. Turn the Power Switch located on the battery



- 2. Install new batteries in both Bobo the Hand Puppet and Bobbie the Receiver Doll according to the Battery Installation Instruction.
- 3. PAIRING SETUP To pair up both devices' connection, turn the Power Switch located on the battery compartment of both devices to "ON" position. Pairing setup of the devices has to be initiated together and within 15 seconds. (See Fig. 6)



4. Pairing setup is done when you hear a "BLEEP" sound. Repeat the above steps if the devices fail to

- 1. You can start sending messages when your devices are successfully paired up.
- 2. Press the Talk button located at the bottom of Bobo's left ear. (See Fig. 7) Start talking followed by the "BLEEP" sound.




- 3. Press the Talk button located at the bottom of Bobo's left ear again when you have finished recording your message/ story.
- 4. Your message/ story will be automatically saved in Bobbie the Receiver Doll.
- 5. To listen to the message thru Bobbie, press the Play button located at Bobbie's left ear. (See Fig. 9) Press the Play button to repeat playing message recorded.

6. You can record your message/ story with a maximum length of 2

All messages stored will be deleted when the batteries are removed from the unit. To avoid damage to any system

To preserve battery life, the Interactive Hand Puppet Set™ will automatically turn off after 15 minutes without input.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth. Never use solvent or abrasives.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from direct sources of the heat.
- 3. Remove the batteries when not using it for an extended period of time. 4. Avoid dropping the unit. NEVER try to dismantle it.
- 5. Always keep the unit away from water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Correction
Your Bobbie & Friends* Interactive Hand Puppet Set™ stop working or do not pair up	Incorrect battery polarities	Ensure that the batteries are installed correctly
	Weak batteries	Replace with new batteries; to ensure optimal performance, we always recommend batteries to be replaced for both devices
	The operating tempature is out of working range	Do not use the unit in extreme temperatures
You cannot send or receive messages	Your devices are not paired up	PairUp the devices according to the initial setup procedures (for first time use) or hold and press the button located on the right ear of Bobo & Bobbie till you hear a "BLEEP" sound
	The receiving signal is weak due to a large obstructing object	Avoid operating the Interactive Hand Puppet Set™ too far apart if there are large objects that will interfere with the signal
	Interference from electronic devices such as a computer or TV	Turn the devices that maybe interfering off or move further away from the devices
	Weak batteries	Replace with new batteries; to ensure optimal performance, we always recommend batteries to be replaced for both devices
Some words of a transmission are cut-off	Incorrect use of the talk button	Press the Talk Button, wait one second followin the "BLEEP" sound to begin speaking. After you have finished speaking, wait one second before pressing the Talk Button again
	Your Message/ Story is too long	The duration of your message/ story should be less than 2 minutes
Voice distortion	Speaking too close or too loud	Hold the unit 2-3 inches from your mouth. Speak in a normal voice. Do not whisper or yel into the microphone
Echo or feedback noise	The units are operating too close together	Keep the units at least 2 feet apart
