

VOR (Voice Operated Recording)

Recording only when sounds exists. So you can treat recording time sufficiently.

You can adjust recording sensibility according to the noise around and distance from sound source.

Message Scanning

You can rapidly search the desired part of the message during playback.

Time Display

Present time is shown on display.

Alarm

You can set the alarm as you want.

Recording the Phone Conversation

You can record important phone conversation.

# Precautions





# Preparing

# Description of the Unit





#### Accessories:

Battery (AAAx1EA), Earphone, External MIC, Hand Strap, USB Cable, Audio Cable, Telephone Adaptor, Telephone Cable, CD-ROM, User's Manual.

#### Insert Battery

1. Open the battery cover.

Pushing cover, and slide it off as following arrow direction.

2. Insert the battery noting the correct polarity and close the cover.

The current time is shown. To set the current time, refer to page \_\_\_.

3. Checking the battery condition



Connect DC Adaptor

You can use this unit without batteries by DC adaptor.

Specification of DC Adaptor


You have to purchase the DC adaptor suitable for following requirements, and then connect it.

If a adaptor is not suitable for following requirements, it may cause a fatal defect.

• External diameter: 2.35 ø

Internal diameter: 0.7 ø

• Regular output: Voltage - 4.5 ~ 5V, Current - 300mA and over.



NOTE

Please use it after checking the polarity of DC adaptor because it may cause the trouble of the unit if the polarity is changed.

#### Basic Functions

#### Selecting Voice Recorder / MP3(Music) Mode

You can record the messages at the Voice Recorder mode and listen to the digital music at the MP3 mode with this unit. First select the mode you want.

To select the Voice Recorder Mode

Slide the MP3/VOICE switch to VOICE mode.

The recording folder, message No. and time are displayed.

Voice recording and playing the message are available.

To select the MP3(Music) mode

Slide the MP3/VOICE switch to MP3 mode.

MP3 file No. and playing time are shown. You can listen to the music.

NOTE

If you do not press any button over a minute, this unit will be automatically off and show present time. We call it "stand-by" mode.

#### Adjusting the Volume

You can adjust the volume level from 0 to 30.

Increasing the volume

Press + (up-side) of Jog button.

The sound becomes louder by pressing the button.



Decreasing the volume

Press (down-side) of Jog button.

The sound becomes smaller by pressing the button



#### NOTE

.You cannot adjust the volume at stand-by mode.

To escape from stand-by mode, press MENU/PAUSE button.

Listening to the Music/Message through earphone

You can listen to the Music and Messages more clearly with the earphone.

Connect the earphone to output Ear. jack.

You can listen to the music through earphone.

#### Setting the Holding Function

Slide the Hold button to down side.

All buttons are not operated.

# 1 Voice Recorder

#### Recording

1. Select the file to record message at File mode in Menu.

Each time you press + , of Jog button, each 4 file indicator A B C D comes on in order.

1. Move MIC toward the sound source and then push REC/STOP button. Recording is started.

The red lamp turns on and recording is started The recording number and time are displayed.

2. To stop the recording, press REC/STOP button again.

The lamp turns off and recorded contents are saved.





#### NOTE

· In the case that memory is full or the number of message in a file is over, then 'FULL' is shown on LCD and you cannot record any more.

Please erase unnecessary messages to record.

#### Playback

- 1. Press • or of jog button, and select recording No. to play.
- 2. Press PLAY/STOP button.

Playing time is displayed and playing is started.

3. To stop playing, press PLAY/STOP button again.

#### ♦ To pause Recording / Playback

· To pause recording or playing, press MENU/PAUSE button during recording or playback.

To restart recording press MENU/PAUSE again.

After 10 minutes at 'Pause' status, recording stops automatically.



#### To monitor during recording

· Connect earphone to the unit, you can monitor the contents during recording.

#### To add Index

· Press • • of jog button during recording, the new recording No. is made and the message is recorded in new file.

#### Scan Playback

· Keep pressing PLAY/STOP button at least 3 seconds.

The first part of each message in the current file will be scanned for 5 seconds.

#### REW and FF during playback

· If you press • • of jog button during playback, it plays as jumping forward or backward fast.

#### Section Repeating

- 1. Press the center of jog button at the start of the section you want to repeat during playing.
  - 4 is shown.
  - 2. Press the center of jog button again at the end of the section you want to repeat.
    - ☐ is shown, then it repeats playback from ☐ to ☐ (☐ -☐).

To cancel this function, press any button.





#### End of the section

#### Erasing the Message

[Erasing one recorded message]

- 1. Select the message to erase by pressing • or • of jog button.
- 2. Select 'On' by pressing ERASE button at least 3 seconds.

"dEL: On" is shown and the message No. blinks on display.

Each time you press + , of jog button, On FI AL comes on in order.

- On(ONE) : Erasing the message
- FI(FOLD): Erasing all messages in one file
- AL(ALL) : Erasing all messages
- 3. Press ERASE button again.

"Ok"display and selected message is erased.

When you erase one message, the number of messages are arranged automatically.

Caution

Once erased messages never be restored. Check before erasing.

[Erasing all messages in a file]

1. Select the folder to erase by pressing + , of jog button at FILE mode in MENU.

Each time you press jog button, file indicator A B C D comes on in order.

2. Press ERASE button, and select F1 by pressing + , of jog button.

dEL: FI'is shown and message No. blinks on display.

Each time you press  $\boldsymbol{+}$  , of jog button, On FI AL comes on in order.

- On(ONE) : Erasing the message
- FI(FOLD): Erasing all messages in one file
- AL(ALL) : Erasing all messages
- 3. Press ERASE button again.

"Ok"display and all messages in the selected folder will be erased.

Caution

Once erased messages never be restored. Check before erasing.

[Erase all messages in the unit]

1. Press ERASE button at least 2 seconds, and select 'AL' by pressing + , of jog button.

dEL: AL'is shown and 'A, B, C, D' blinks.

Each time you press + , of jog button, oN  $\,$  FI  $\,$  AL comes on in turn.

- On(ONE) : Erasing one message
- FI(FOLD) : Erasing all messages in one file
- AL(ALL) : Erasing all messages
- 2. Press ERASE button again.

"Ok"display and all recorded messages will be erased.

Once erased messages never be restored. Check before erasing.

# 2 MP3 Player

#### Playback

- 1. Select the MP3 file number pressing • or • of jog button.
- 2. Press PLAY/STOP button.

Playing is started and the playing time is displayed.

3. To stop playing, press PLAY/STOP button again.

# Section Repeat

- 1. Press the center of jog button at the start of the section you want to repeat during playing.
  - 4 is shown.
- 2. Press the center of jog button again at the end of the section you want to repeat.
  - - D is shown, then it repeats playback from to D (• D).

To cancel this function, press any button.





Start of the section

End of the section

- To play the desired section in MP3 (Music) file
  - · Press • or • of jog button during playing.

The message is played at the moment you release the button.

#### Scan Playback

· Keep pressing PLAY/STOP button at least 3 seconds.

The first part of each message in the current file will be scanned for 5 seconds.

#### To pause Playback

· To pause playing, press MENU/PAUSE button during playing.

To restart recording press MENU/PAUSE again.

After 10 minutes at 'Pause' status, recording stops automatically.

#### Erasing MP3 (Music) File

[Erasing one MP3 (Music) file]

- 1. Select the MP3 (Music) file that you would erase by controlling • or • of jog button.
- 2. Keep pressing ERASE button for at least 2 seconds to select on.

"dEL: On" is shown and "MP3 file" blinks.

Each time you push + , of jog button, On AL comes on in turn.

- On(ONE) : Erasing one MP3 File.

- AL(ALL) : Erasing all MP3 files.
- 3. Press ERASE button again.

"Ok" is shown and selected file is erased.

After erasing, the number of MP3 file is arranged automatically.

[To erase all MP3 files]

1. Keep pressing ERASE button at least 2 seconds and select 'AL' by controlling + , of jog button.

"dEL: AL" is shown and "MP3" blinks.

Each time you push + , of jog button, On AL comes on in turn.

- On(ONE) : Erasing the selected MP3 File.
- AL(ALL) : Erasing all MP3 files in the unit.
- 2. Press ERASE button again.

"Ok" is shown and selected all MP3 files are erased.

NOTE

The erased MP3 file cannot be restored. Check before erasing.

#### How to use the MENU

To use the unit more efficiently, it will be very helpful if you know well how to set the menu. Basic method for setting menu is as below.

1. Keep pressing MENU/PAUSE button at least 3 seconds at stand-by mode or during playing. Menu setting mode is shown.

Each time you press MENU/PAUSE button, the 'Menu' will be changed as bellow.

- VOICE mode (stand-by mode)
  - ·In order of MOd REP VOR MIC LOCK FILE HEAR ARM dATE
  - VOICE mode (playback)
    - In order of REP
  - MP3 mode (stand-by mode)
    - In order of EQ BASS REP HEAR ARM dATE
  - MP3 mode (playback)
    - In order of REP EQ BASS

To revere the Menu, press • • of jog button.

- 2. Select the desired menu by pressing MENU/PAUSE button.
- 3. Select the desired function by pressing + , of jog butto

Each time you push + , of jog button, the function is changed.

4. To finish, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.

It will be run as you select.

#### 

- Changing Recording Mode
- 1. Select MOD mode in menu.

'MOD: SP' is shown.

2. Select MOD by pressing + , of jog button.

Each time you press the jog button, SP H SH comes on in order.

3. After selecting MOd, push PLAY, ERASE or REC button.

- Repeating the Playback
- 1. Select REP mode in menu.

REP: oF is shown.

2. Select repeat function by pressing + , of jog button.

Each time you press the jog button, of FI AL Co comes on in order.

3. Press PLAY, ERASE, REC button after setting up.

#### Setting the VOR Recording

VOR(Voice Operating Record) function is that the unit records only when the sound exists.

- 1. Select VOR mode in menu.
  - 'VOR: oF' is shown.
- 2. Select ON or OF by pressing + , of jog button.

Each time you press the jog button, of On comes on in order.

3. After selecting, push PLAY, ERASE or REC button.

- Adjusting the Recording Sensitivity
- 1. Select MIC mode in menu.
  - 'MIC Hi' is shown.
- 2. Select recording sensitivity by controlling + , of jog button.

Each time you press the jog button, Hi Lo comes on in order.

3. After selecting, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.





MIC HI(High Sensitivity)
Sound source is far or
there is little noise.

MIC LO(Standard Sensitivity) Sound source is near or there is much noise.

- Setting the Lock Function
- 1. Select LOCK mode in menu.

LOCK oF 'is shown.

2. Press + , of jog button to select ON or OF.

Each time you press the jog button, of On comes on in order.

3. To finish, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.

NOTE

The locked messages is NOT erased.

- Setting the FILE
- 1. Select FILE mode in menu.

FILE: A 'is shown.

2. Press + , of jog button to select the FILE to record.

Each time you press the jog button, A B C D comes on in order.

3. To finish, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.



## Setting the Hear Aid Function

- 1. Connect the earphone to the earphone terminal.
- 2. Select HEAR mode in menu.

HEAR: On 'is shown and this function works.

Adjust the volume by pressing + , of jog button.

HEAR: oF 'will be shown if unplug the earphone from the unit.

3. To finish this function, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.



# Setting Alarm

1. Select the ARM mode in menu.

'ARM: oF' is shown.

Select Alarm ON or OF by pressing + , of jog button to.
 Each time you press the jog button, oF On comes on in order.

3. Setting 'hour' and 'minute' by pressing • • of jog button at ARM ON mode. 'Hour' blinks and then 'minute' blinks when you press • • of jog button after time setting.

At the same way, set the 'minute'.

4. After setting, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.



To finish the ARM setting, change Alarm On oF at ARM mode.

# • Setting the current time

1. Select DATA mode in menu.

'dATE' is shown, and year blinks.

- 2. Set year, month, date & hour, minute, second by controlling jog button.
  - + , of jog button : Changing set contents
  - or ► of jog button: Shifting to left or right.
- 3. To finish, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.







# 2 MP3 Player

- Selecting the Sound Mode
- 1. Select EQ mode in menu.

"EQ: oF" or "ROCK, JAZZ, CLASS1" is shown.

2. Select the desired sound mode by controlling  $\, + \,$  . of jog button.

Each time you press the jog button, oF ROCK JAZZ CLASS1 comes on in order.

3. After setting, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.

- ♦ Setting the Bass Mode
- 1. Select BASS mode in menu.

"BASS: oF" is shown.

- 2. Select the desired sound mode by controlling + , of jog button.
- 3. After setting, press PLAY, ERASE or REC button.

- Repeating the Playback Setting method is same as the Voice Recorder.
- Setting the Hear Aid Function Setting method is same as the Voice Recorder.
- Setting Alarm Setting method is same as the Voice Recorder.
- Setting the current time Setting method is same as the Voice Recorder.

# Connecting to the External Device

#### Connecting to the External Microphone

You can easily record the message by using the external microphone.

- 1. Connect the external microphone to the MIC terminal of the voice recorder.
- 2. Press REC/STOP button.

It starts recording.

3. To stop the recording, press REC/STOP button again.

#### Connecting to the Telephone

You can record telephone conversation.

- 1. Connect the Voice Recorder to the telephone using telephone adaptor.
- 2. Press REC/STOP button during conversation.

The conversation will be recorded.

3. To stop recording, press REC/STOP button again.

NOTE

However, you cannot record the conversation through the digital telephone.

#### Connecting to Audio System

To record the contents of the Audio in the Voice Recorder

- 1. Connect the Voice Recorder to the audio system.
- 2. Press REC/STOP button of the Voice Recorder and the playing button of audio at the same time.
- 3. To stop recording, press REC/STOP button again.

To record the contents of Voice Recorder into Audio

- 1. Connect the Voice Recorder to the audio system.
- 2. Select the message which you would record into audio.

Refer to No. 1 of Playback.

- 3. Press PLAY/STOP button of the Voice Recorder and the recording button of audio at the same time.
- 4. To stop recording, press PLAY/STOP button of the Voice Recorder and stop button of Audio at the same time.

# Connecting to PC

You can copy the message in the Voice Recorder to PC. Also, you can play and edit the sound files on PC.

Refer to 'Help' of the 'Express Media Player' for the details.

For playing: Sound Card, Speaker For recording: Sound Card, Microphone

## Connecting to PC(cont.)

To manage the recorded messages with 'Express Manager', connect the Voice Recorder to PC with USB cable.

#### NOTE

Before connect the USB Cable, set the Express Manager' in PC first.

## Troubleshooting

Check for the following points first if any problem happens.

LCD window does not work.	Isn't the battery exhausted? Replace with new battery. Is the battery installed correctly? Insert the battery with the correct polarity.				
Recording does not work	Isn't the Hold switch set? Release the Hold switch. Is there no space for recording? Erase the unnecessary messages. Isn't the battery exhausted? Replace with new battery.				
Playing does not work	Isn't the Hold switch set? Release the Hold switch. Is there any messages recorded? Check for the message number. Isn't the battery exhausted? Replace with new battery.				
No sound output from the speaker	Isn't the volume is set to '0'? Adjust the volume. Is the earphone plugged in the unit? Unplug the earphone.				
No sound output from the earphone	Isn't the volume is set to '0'? Adjust the volume. Isn't the earphone unplugged in the unit? Plug the earphone.
