User Manual

1. The device has two buttons.
2. Push down the button, the LED will turn on indicating that the device is transmitting an encoded waveform, Code Word. The Code Word includes Synchronous Bit Waveform and Address/Data Bit Waveform.
3. Release the button, the LED turns off and the device stops the transmission.
4. Each Button represents different Data Bit.
5. The device is powered by a 12 Battery

Note: This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules.
