The changes filed under this application are as follows:

1. Collocate the MC8755 with Bluetooth radio FCC ID: MCLJ07H081 and WLAN FCC ID: PPD-AR5BXB6 in a new host laptop.
2. The MC8755 antenna in the new host laptop is from a different supplier. The antenna type remains the same and the peak gain is lower in both 850MHz and 1900MHz bands.
