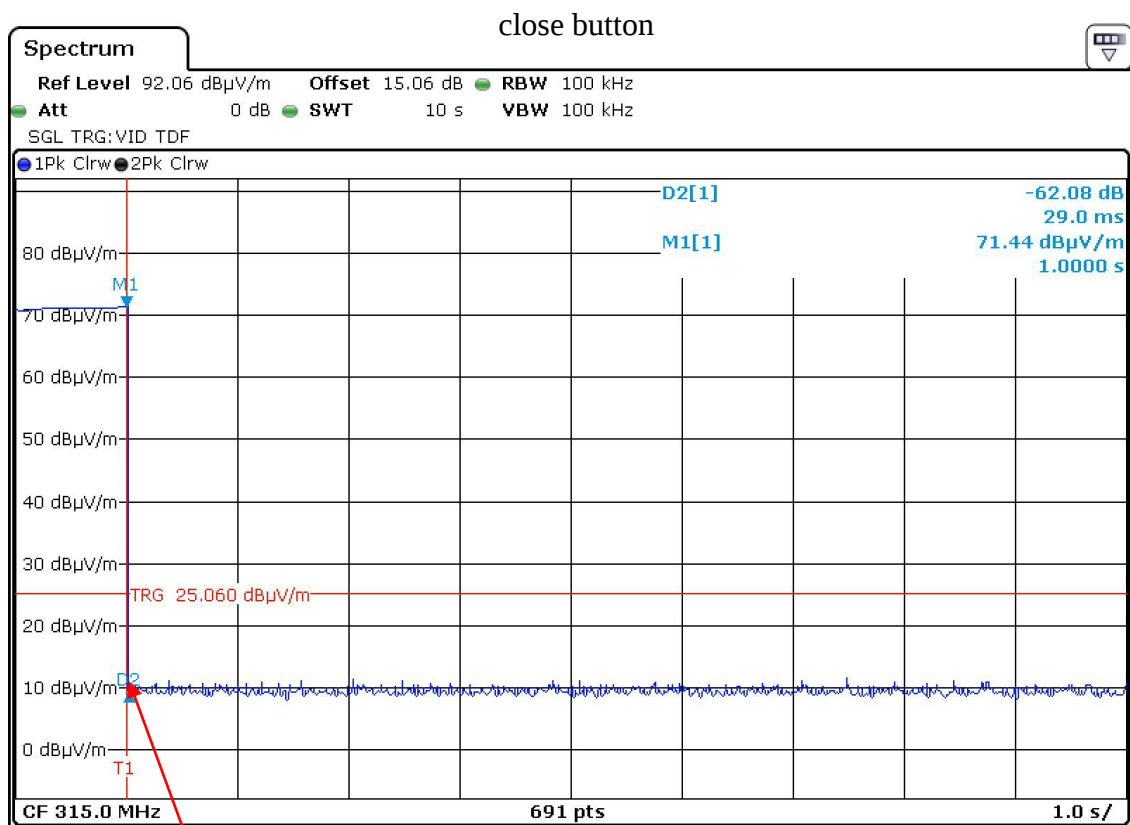


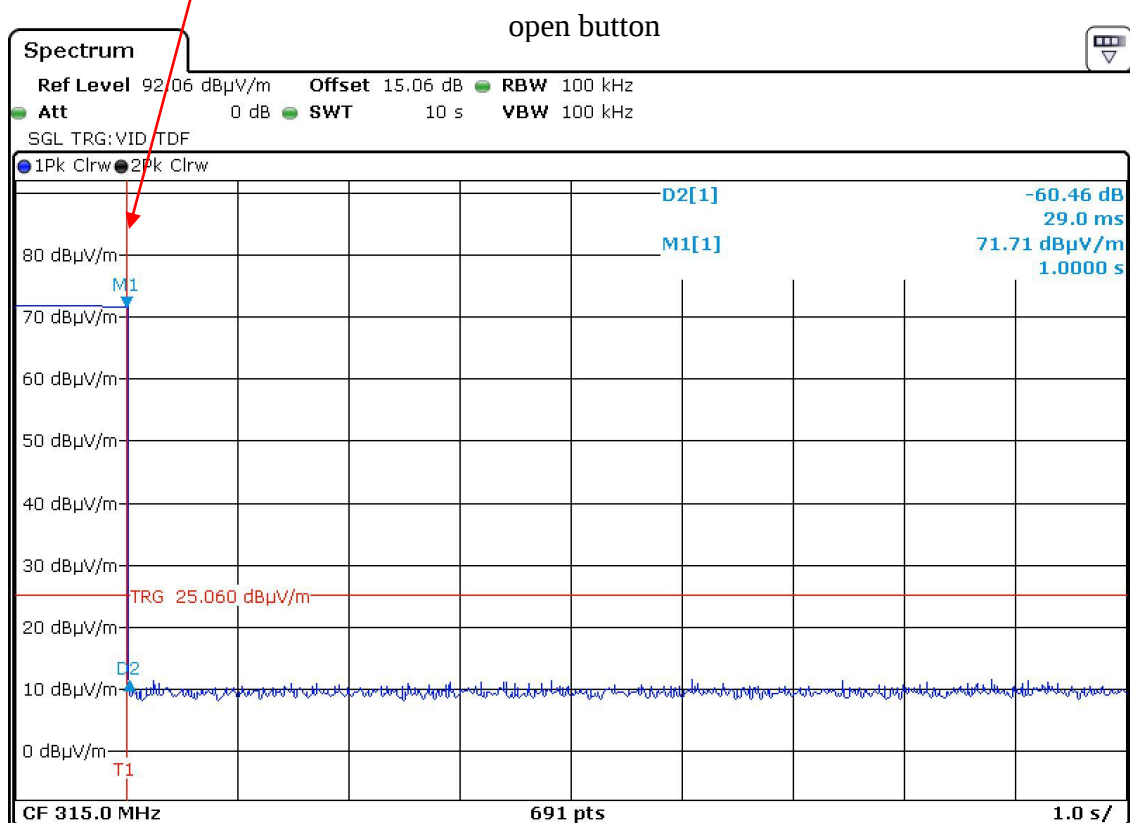

Periodic Operation Characteristics

FCC Part 15 C section 15.231 (a)(1) A manually operated transmitter shall employ a switch that will automatically deactivate the transmitter within not more than 5 seconds of being released.

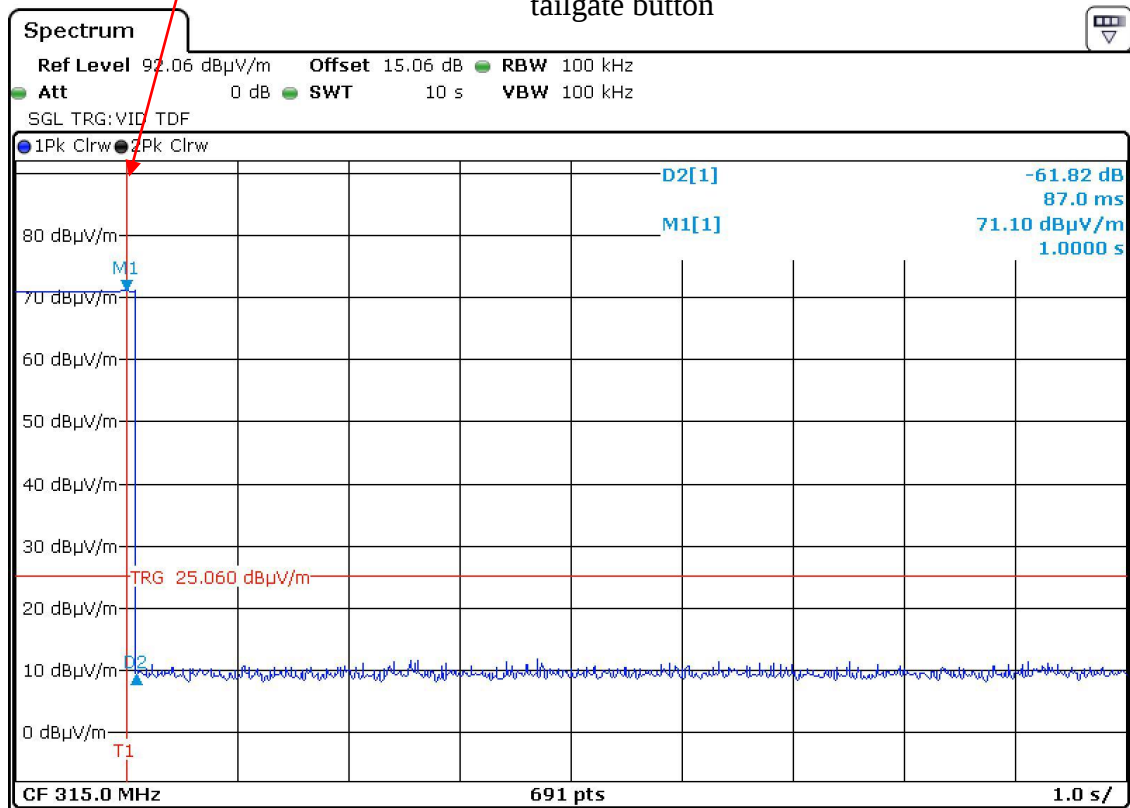


release point

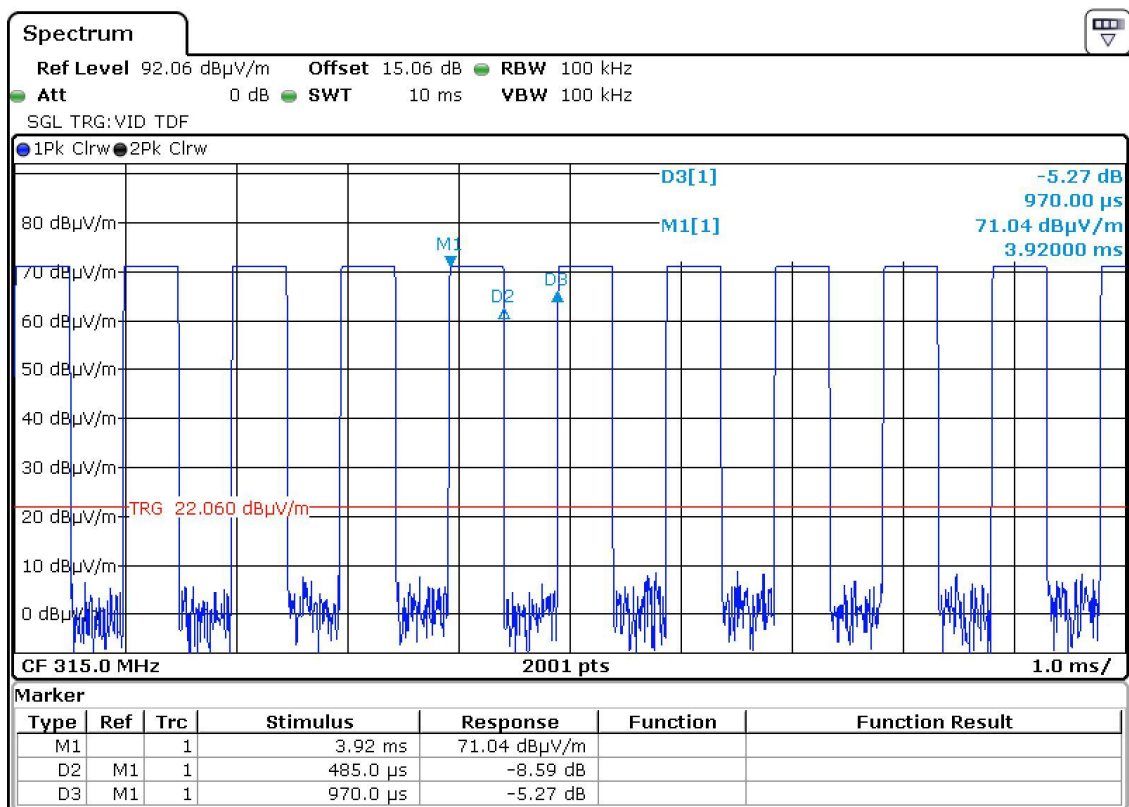
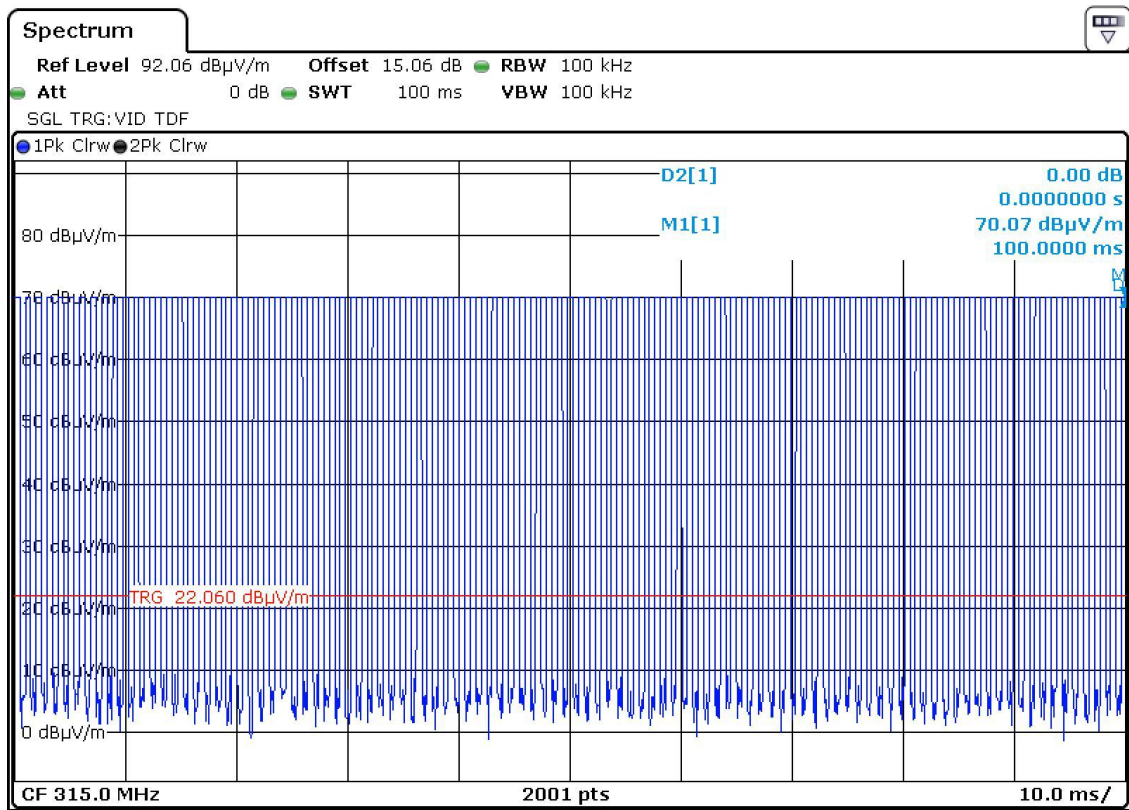


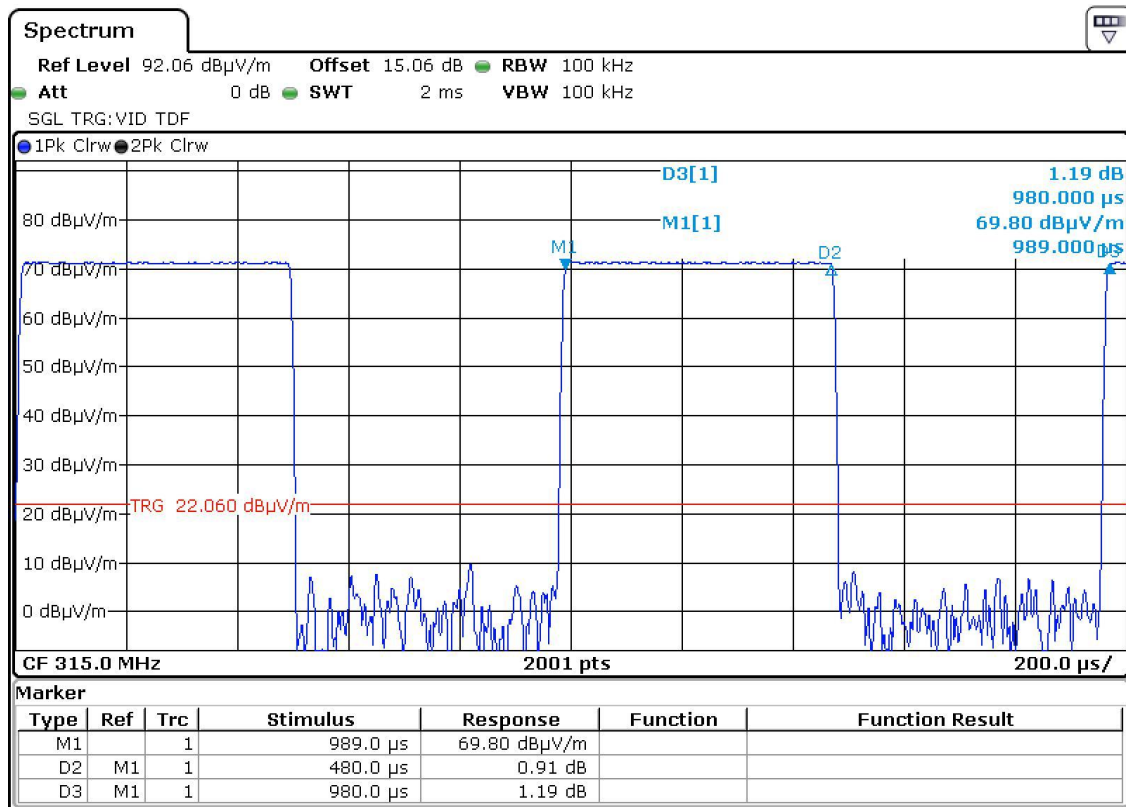

Worst case transmission time in any 100 ms time window





The measured worst case duration for a single pulse transmission in any 100ms time window is 49.64 ms.

Maximum transmitting duration in every 100 ms period: 4.9 ms

Averaging factor = $20 \cdot \log(49.64/100) = -6.0$ dB
