

**REQUEST FOR NONDISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION IN
CERTIFICATION APPLICATIONS**

1. Identification of information to be withheld from the public

- System Description ("Description 2.4GHz Rev1.1.pdf") – 9 pages

2. Applications in which the information appears

- FCC Rules part 15 subpart C (FCC ID: NE9TM2001)
- FCC Rules part 68

3. Degree to which the information is commercial in nature, or contains trade secrets

All of the identified information is confidential and includes trade secrets. It is not publicly known how our product performs its tasks. The submitted schematics, parts lists, and technical description documentation reveal intellectual property that is proprietary and should not be released.

4. Degree to which the information concerns a product or service that is subject to competition

All of the identified information concerns a system that is marketed in the highly competitive wireless telecommunications market.

5. How disclosure of the information will cause competitive harm

Disclosure of any of the identified information could enable competitors to benefit improperly from our hard-won intellectual property and harm our competitive advantage.

6. Measures taken to keep the information confidential
