Declaration

We, **HTC Corporation**, declare that the device of **FCC ID: NM8CDMAHTL21**, **Model Name: CDMA HTL21**, disable ad-hoc and personal Hotspot function for 5250Mhz ~ 5350Mhz and 5470Mhz ~ 5725Mhz that software and associated drivers will not initiate any transmission on DFS frequencies and the device does not support radar detection capability. This includes transmission for become ad-hoc peer to peer modes.

Moreover, for 2.4G part of this device, only channels 1~11, will be used in North America and bands of 802.11 b/g/n channels 12~13, non-US frequency, are disabled. Country code selection is also disabled.
