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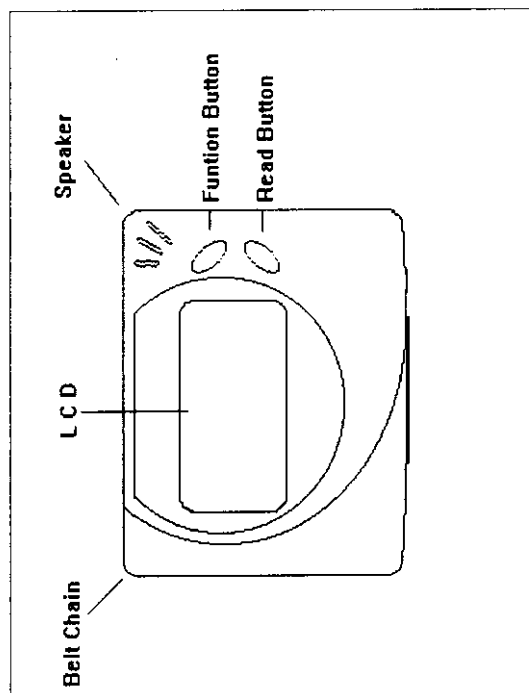

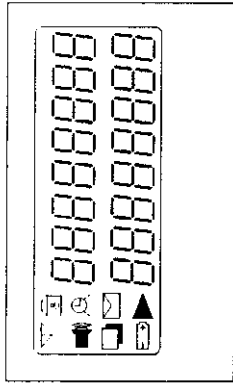

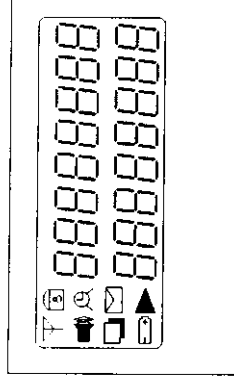

OPERATION OF HANSCOM PAGER

● . Power ON

Press Function Button(■) for 2 seconds.

Your pager gives an alert by either a sound or vibration, indicating it is on, after return to the standby screen.

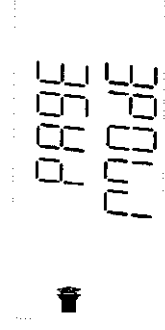


● . Power OFF

Press Function Button(■) The back light comes on.

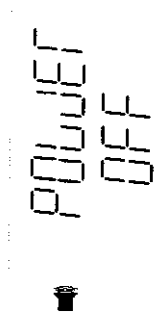
Then Press Function Button(■) again for 2 seconds.

The prompt "PAGE MODE" displayed.



Press read Button(▲) for menu select until you reach "POWER OFF"

Then Function Button(■) to turn your pager off.

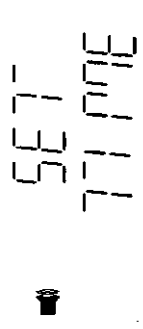


● . Default Settings

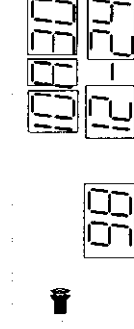
- * Alert mode : sound

SETTING THE TIME & DATE

Press Function Button(■) The back light comes on.
Then Press Function Button(■) again for 2 seconds.
The prompt "PAGE MODE" displayed. Press Read Button(▲) for menu select
until you reach "SET TIME"

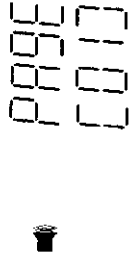


Press Function Button(■), First digit will be blinking.
Press Read Button(▲) to select hour, minute, AM/PM, month, day, year.
Press Function Button(■) to setting the data.

Receiving and Reading a message

When a message is received, the pager alert for 8 seconds, and "PAGE[01]" will be displayed. Press any button to stop the alert.



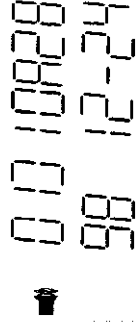

Press Read Button(▲). The first display will be date and time stamp.

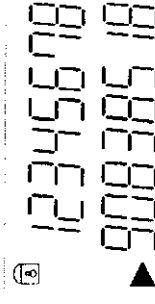

Press Read Button(▲) to display the message.

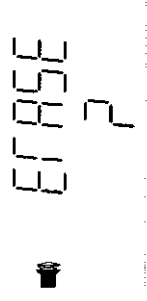
Then press read button(▲) again to read the next ones.

ERASING OF MESSAGES

NOTICE : Read all stored messages before you enter this mode.

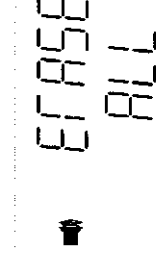
This procedure will erase all stored message.

"PAGE MODE" will be displayed. Then Press function button(■) again for 2 sec.

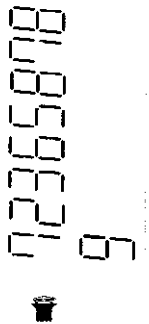
Press read button((▲)to select until you reach "ERASE ALL".

Press function button(■) It will be erase all stored message. and return to the standby screen.

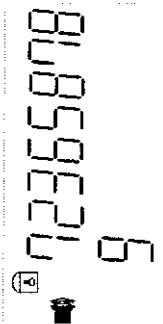


LOCKING THE MESSAGE.

Press Function button(■). it will be Lock with symbol.

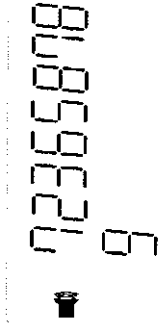
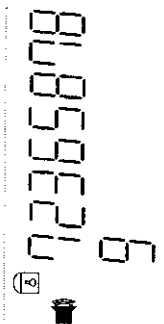


The *symbol indicates that your message is saved.

UNLOCKING THE MESSAGE.

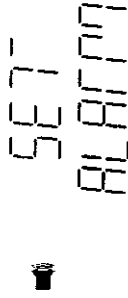
If you want to unlocking the messages.

If not, press Read Button(▲) to cancel.



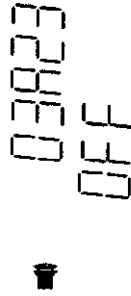
SETTING THE ALARM

Press Function Button(■) return to the standby screen.



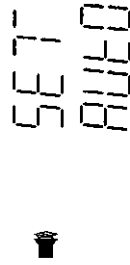

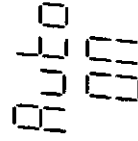
SETTING THE AUTO POWER ON/OFF

CHANGING THE ALERT MODE

- **Setup silent (from sound or vibration to silent)**

Press Function Button(■) The back light comes on.
Then Press Function Button(■) for 2 seconds.
The prompt "PAGE MODE" displayed. Then press Function button(■) again.
"Silent ?" will be displayed.

Press function button(■) again.

Then return to the standby screen, and The pager mode will be silent mode.

- **Setup vibration (from sound or silent to vibration)**

Press Function Button(■) The back light comes on.
Then Press Function Button(■) for 2 seconds.
The prompt "PAGE MODE" displayed. press Function button(■).
Press read button(▲) menu select until you reach "Vibrate ?"

Press function button(■) again.

Then return to the standby screen, and the pager mode will be vibrate mode.

- **Setup melody (from vibration or silent to sound)**

Press Function Button(■) The back light comes on.

Then Press Function Button(■) for 2 seconds.

The prompt "PAGE MODE" displayed. Then press Function button(■).

Press read button(▲) menu select until you reach "Tone ?"

Press function button(■) again, it will selectable the 2 beep tone and 2 melody.

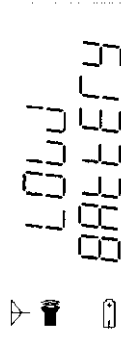
Press read button(▲), to choose a tone(No.1~2) or a melody(No.3~4).

Then press function button(■) to confirm and return to the standby screen.

BATTERY INFORMATION

- **Low Battery indication**

When the battery power reaches low levels, it displays "LOW BATTERY" with sound alert.



- **Replacing the battery**

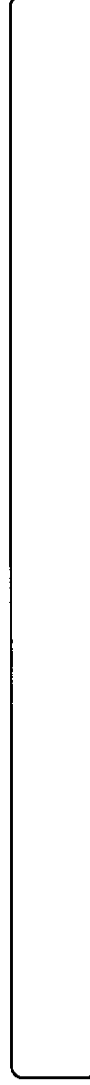
Hanscom pager is designed to operate with AAA size alkaline battery.

To replace the battery, do the following:

- ① Slide locking switch to the unlock position.

- ② Slide the battery cover off the pager.
- ③ Remove the old battery and insert a new AAA battery in the direction shown the battery compartment.
- ④ Slide the battery cover back on the pager and slide the battery lock switch to the locked position.

NOTICE : Do not place the battery in backward. If you insert the battery in backward, all the message, time and setting mode will be deleted.
