On behalf of Wide Telecom Inc. we hereby submit the following amendment per your e-mail dated April 11, 2001 requesting additional information for the subject application.

1. There is no manufacturer's belt-clip available for the phone at this time (please see attached letter from applicant). For the body-worn SAR test we established a separation distance of 1cm between the back of the phone and the surface of the planar phantom, which is the typical separation distance a standard belt-clip would provide for this type of phone. The user's manual warning statement states that the use of third-party body-worn accessories must maintain the minimum separation distance required, and must not contain any metallic components in order to comply with FCC RF exposure requirements. If a manufacturer's belt-clip becomes available in the future, the applicant will perform the necessary body-worn SAR tests and FCC submittal.
