DESCRIPTION OF THE RADIO CONTROL PITCHING MACHINE - Tx

The Radio Control Pitching Machine - Tx is used to trigger a pitching machine to pitch when directed. The EUT operates at a transmit frequency of 38 kHz. The transmitter will be located inside a baseball bat. This device is part of the Power Ponytail Softball Radio Control Pitching Machine. The system also includes a 38 kHz receiver located at the base of the pitching machine which is not subject to FCC regulations.
