



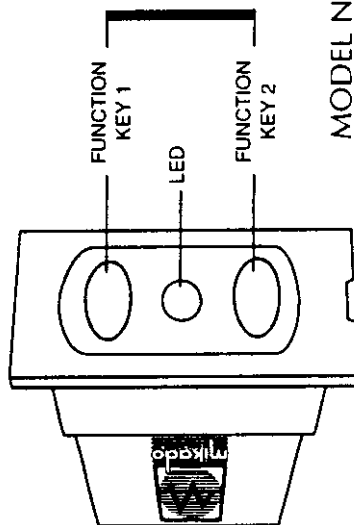

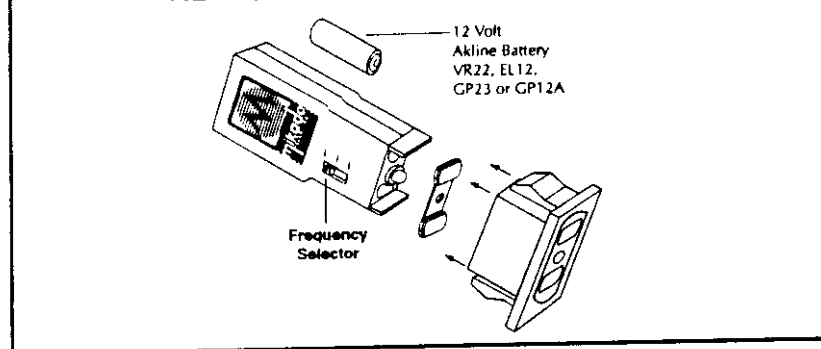

390Mhz	GENIE, SEARS, LIFT-MASTER, WAYNE DALTON & MASTER MECHANIC, CHAMBERLAIN
310Mhz	STANLEY 310, LINEAR, MOORE-O-MATIC
300Mhz	STANLEY 300, MULTI-CODE

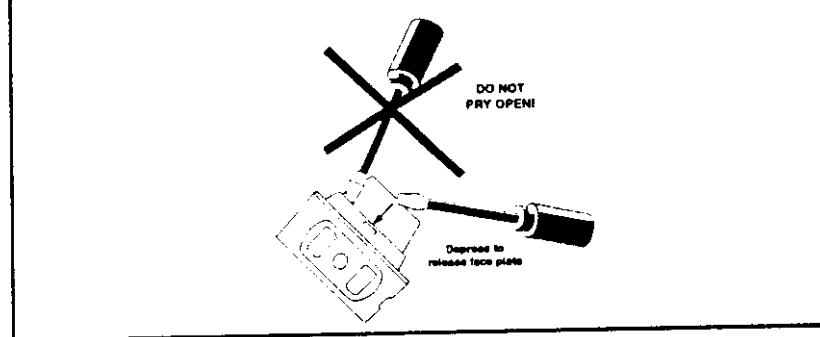
FUNCTION	INSTRUCTION	LED INDICATOR	LED PULSE
Empty Code	Ready to program new code. If indicator displays rapid pulse see Resetting Function or Changing Secret Code Function .	- Single short pulse - LED off	
Select Frequency	Choose either 390Mhz, 310Mhz or 300Mhz (frequency must match source transmitter) See "Remote Assembly Diagram".		
Duplicating Secret Code	Select source of transmitter (i.e., Genie car garage opener). Hold both transmitters together. Press and hold both the source transmitter and the Mikado Transmitter function keys moving about until LED indicator begins to pulse rapidly (rapid pulse indicates location of source transmission) until there are 3 solid pulses on the Mikado Transmitter .	- Locate transmitter pulse - Rapid pulse 3 solid pulses	
Changing Secret Code	On the Mikado Transmitter , press the key that you wish to change for 10 seconds (until LED is off). While pressing the key, repeat the step above Duplicating Secret Code .	- Rapid pulse (10 sec) until LED off - Rapid pulse 3 solid pulses	
Resetting 1st or 2nd function keys with programmed secret code	Press the function key that you wish to reset, (either the 1st or 2nd), for 10 seconds (until LED is off). Do not release that key! While holding that key, press the other key 4-7 times until LED pulses 5 times and then turns off. Result: Empty Code.	- Rapid pulse (10 sec) until LED off 5 solid pulses - Reset complete	
Resetting 3rd function key with a programmed secret code	Press the 3rd function key (hold both keys) for 10 seconds (until LED is off). Hold either key while pressing the other key 4-7 times until LED begins pulsing, then hold both keys until LED is off. Result: Empty Code.	- Rapid pulse (10 sec) until LED off 5 solid pulses - Reset complete

Some states do not allow the limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or the exclusion of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

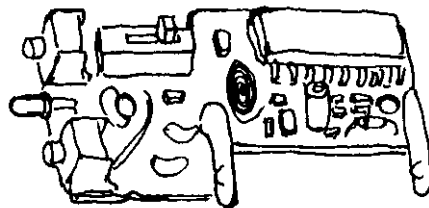
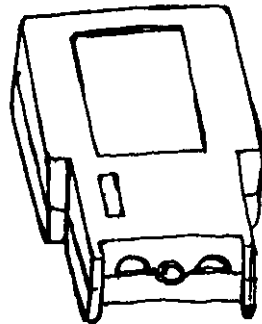
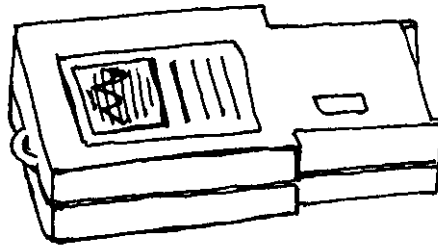
