### **1.0 Product Overview**

The Skyteller POS Terminal is a fully self-contained, battery operated cash register intended to support in-flight foreign exchange and duty-free sales. It is designed for use on top of standard airline duty-free carts. The POS will be transported and stored in a transport case until ready for use.

#### **1.1 Enclosure**

The POS is housed in a self-enclosed ruggedized casing consisting of a base and a display section, hinged together. In the open position, the display is locked into one of several possible positions for viewing and for touch screen operation. All other components are then accessible for use. When closed and secured by the integral combination lock, these two sections form a vandal resistant unit. When the POS is locked closed, the cash drawer is covered and cannot be opened, and no covers, openings or fasteners are exposed. A tamper-resistant serial number for the POS will be visible in this position.

One or more handles and grip features will be provided for moving the unit and repositioning it on top of the duty free cart. Non-skid feet keep the POS in position on the cart top, however the unit will also enable easy repositioning as needed. Finally, the system is designed to be resistant to liquid spills.

#### **1.2 Dimensions and Weight**

Overall size when locked is approximately 10" high x 11" wide x 16" deep.

Total weight is 26 lbs maximum, including batteries but excluding currency and commodities.

#### **1.3 Regulatory Compliance**

- Safety - UL 1950, CSA 950, IEC 801, IEC 950, CE
- EMI - FCC Class B, VDE Class B, CE
- Airlines - RTCA avionics interference

No FAA requirements exist for this class of device.
