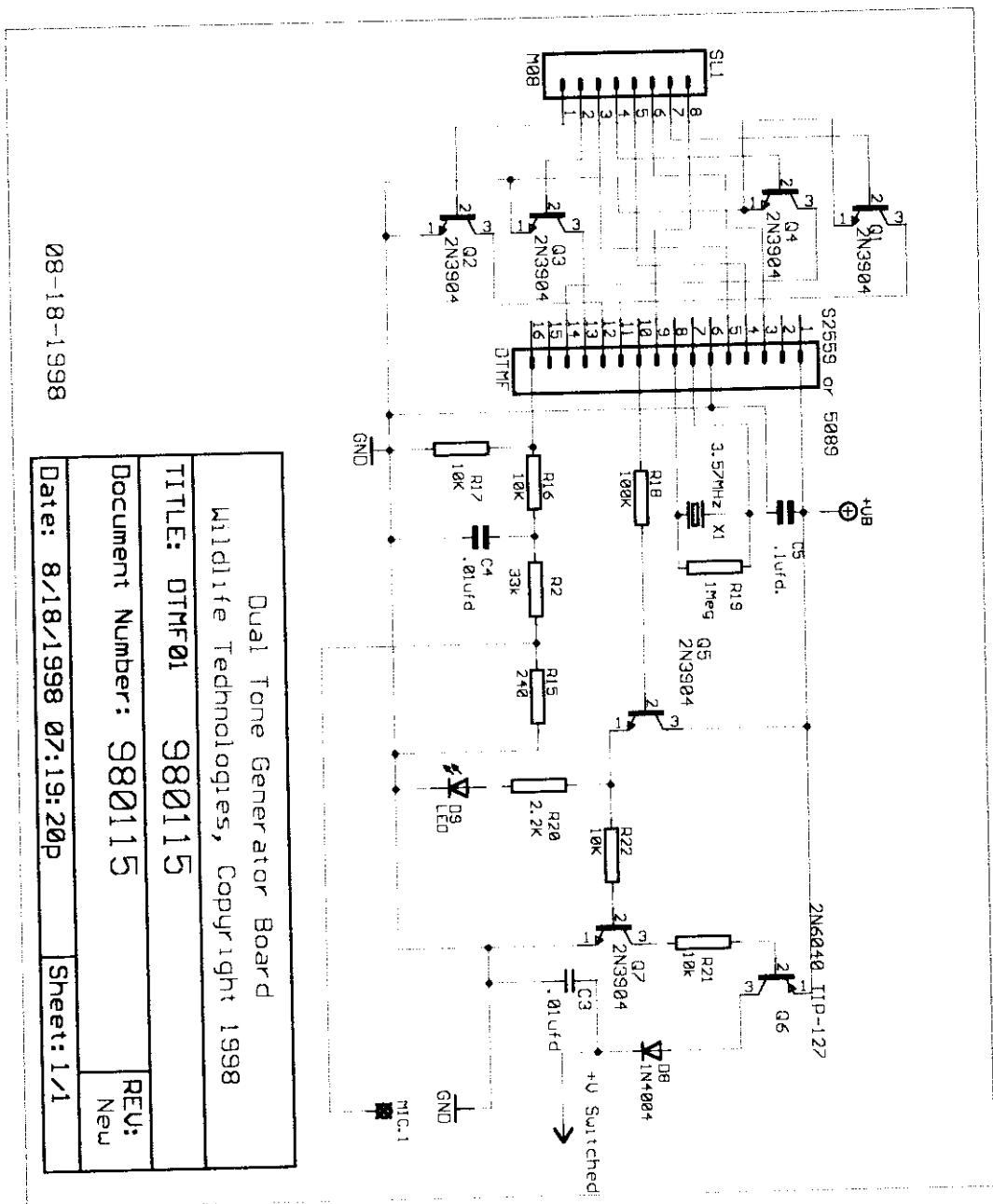

SCHEMATIC DIAGRAMS



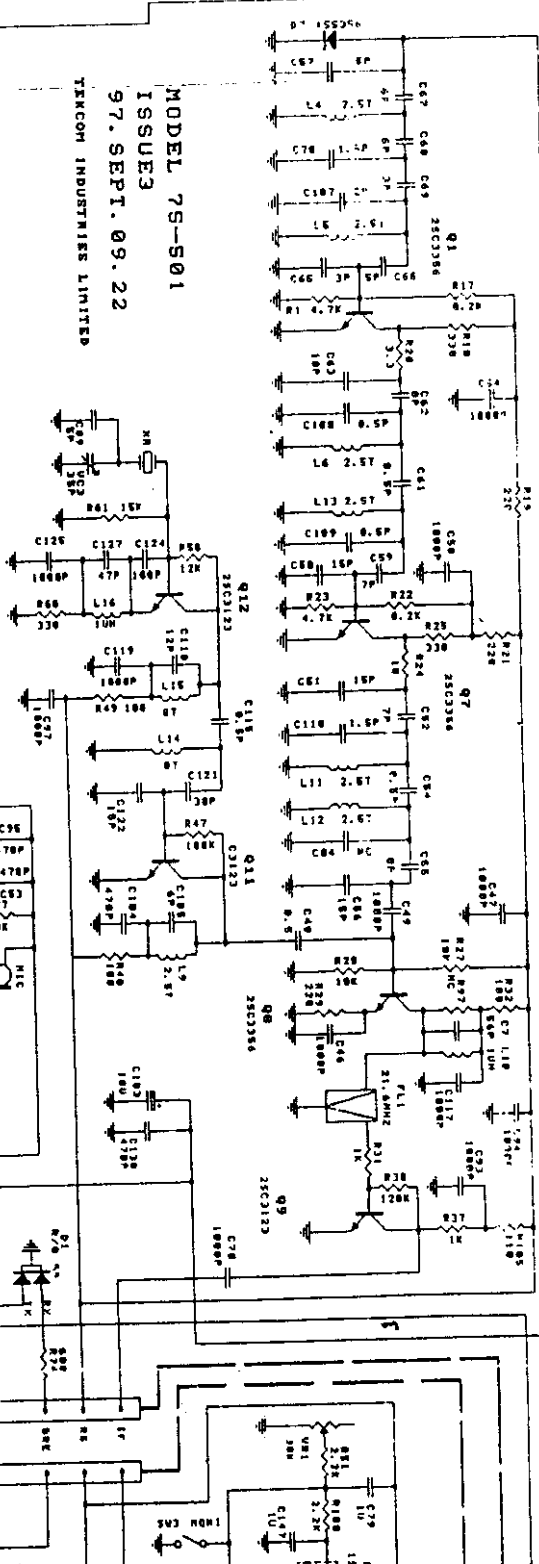

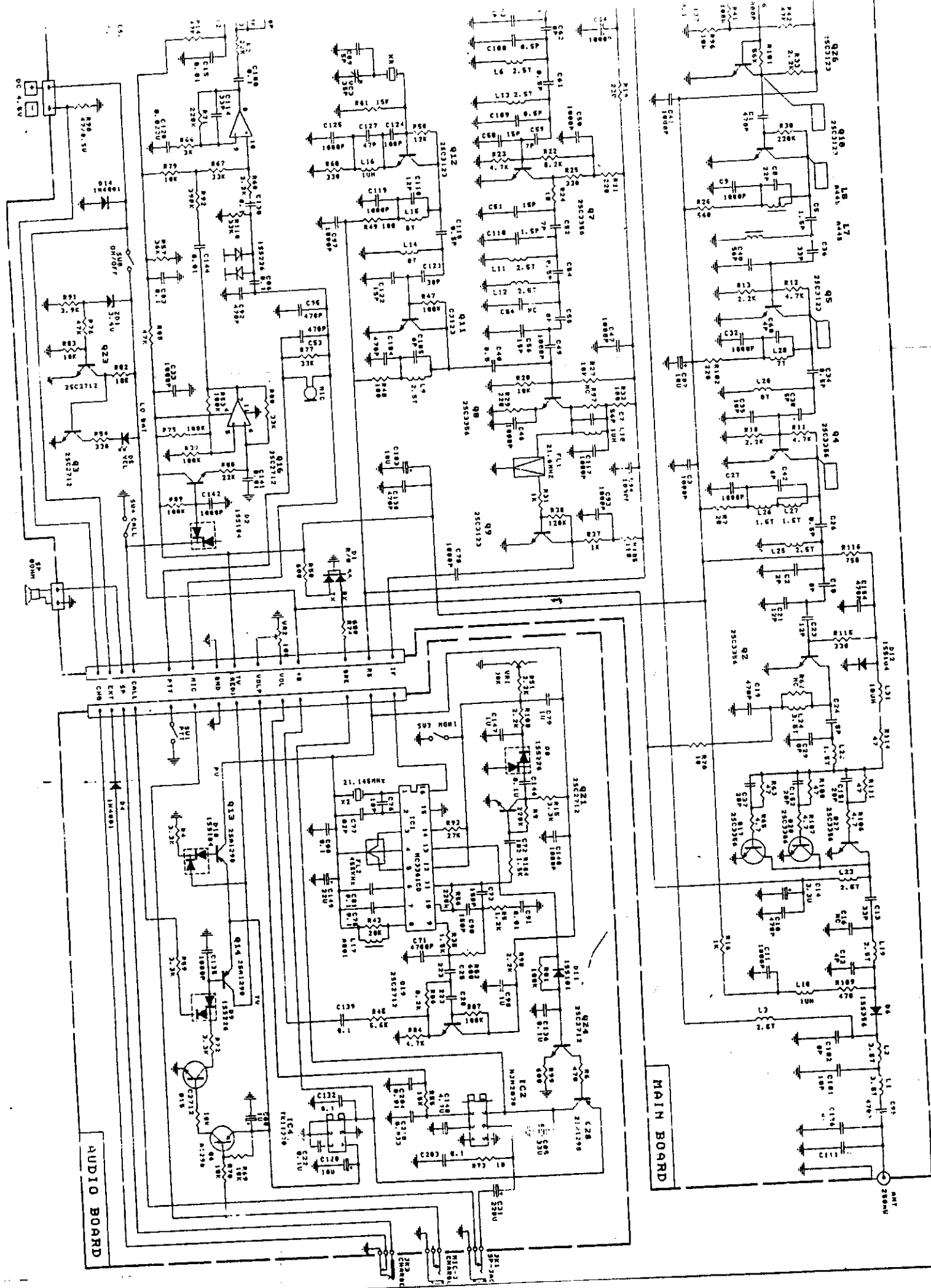
