

4.2 Equations

POWER DENSITY

$$E(V/m) = \text{SQRT} (30 * P * G) / d$$

$$Pd(W/m^2) = E^2 / 377$$

$$S = \text{EIRP} / (4 * \text{Pi} * D^2v)$$

Where:

S = Power density, in mW/cm²

EIRP = Equivalent Isotropic Radiated Power, in mW

D = Separation distance in cm

Power density is converted from units of mW/cm² to units of W/m² by multiplying by 10.

DISTANCE

$$D = \text{SQRT} (\text{EIRP} / (4 * \text{Pi} * S))$$

Where:

D = Separation distance in cm

EIRP = Equivalent Isotropic Radiated Power, in mW

S = Power density in mW/cm²
