FCC Type Acceptance is hereby requested for TelluSart MKII Radar Transponder manufactured by ACR South Africa.

ACR South Africa (ACRSA) is a foreign company controlled by ACR Electronics, Inc. of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.

Inquiry or notice to ACRSA should be directed to my attention at the address noted herein below.

The subject Radar Transponder was originally developed by Plessey Ltd. in South Africa. The Radar Transponder product line was subsequently sold to Halleria Close Corp., also a South African company. Recently ACR Electronics, Inc. acquired Halleria which now operates as ACR South Africa.

A letter from Dr. David Frost (the current CEO of ACRSA) indicating the status of the current South African company is included for your information.

The current European approvals held by Halleria Close Corp. for the transponder were based on testing (conducted in the UK) which closely parallels FCC requirements.
