


A) REMOTE CONTROL UNIT


- One 6 volt battery (type 4LR44/L1325) is already installed.
- To change the battery, slide off the back cover (Fig.A) and replace with a new battery.
- The on/off button is underneath the front cover. Slide open the front cover to press the on/off button.

B) REMOTE LITE

- Slide off the cover and insert two 1.5 volts AA/R6 type batteries. (fig.B) Observe the polarity markings shown in the battery compartment.
- Slide the switch to "ON" position, and the lite turns on instantaneously, to ensure the battery is fully charged.
- The unit can be mounted at any places as you need. A self-stick VELCRO strip is included. The VELCRO strip can adhere to the dash-board or any location you desire. The unit then can be mounted onto the VELCRO strip.
- To turn off the lite, slide the switch to "OFF" position or press the button once from the remote control unit.

OPERATIONS

- The lite will turn on when the push-button of the remote control is pressed (press for one second then release). It will stay on until the next time the push-button is pressed again. The red indicator turns on when the push-button is pressed.
- The unit can be used as a flashlight or a car interior lite by sliding the switch on or off.
- In an open space without any obstructions, the unit can transmit/receive the signal up to 50 feet apart within the line-of-sight.

IMPORTANT

- If the lite fails to turn on, check that the unit are within the distance range. Check the lite switch is not at the "OFF" position. Make sure that all batteries are correctly installed.
- Avoid mounting the unit on the metallic surfaces as the radio signal will not be able to penetrate it. It may reduce the transmission range.
- Avoid placing the units too close to the hot areas whenever possible. It can damage the units and/or batteries.
- Do not mix old batteries with new ones since performance will be affected.
- To extend the battery life, switch to "OFF" position when not in use for a long period of time.
- Do not expose the unit to rain or immerse in water. Unit is not water resistant.
