Dear Mr. Dayhoff:

On behalf of Sierra Wireless Inc. we hereby submit an amendment to the subject application in response to your request as follows:

1. For the body SAR measurements the EUT was positioned relative to the planar section of the phantom so that the area scan performed would measure any hot spot occurring in that region. However, the EUT was inadvertently positioned causing the center of the dipole antenna to be shifted from the center of the phantom. The EUT overlay is adjusted in order to correlate with the location of the hot spot (please see attached revised body SAR test plots). Please note that the actual SAR values determined are not affected by the EUT overlay.
