Hi Dennis,

I decided to get more information from the client with respect to the class II change. See below.

Thanks for the update. With respect to what changed, the firmware on the RPs did not actually change. They were always capable of transmitting at 1893.5MHz. Our error was that we did not approve them to that end of their range because we had not thought of an application that would work between 1893.5 and 1895 only. Then our customer thought of one - meeting construction requirements. We also intend to go through this again pretty soon to extend the RPs to 1892MHz to get enough channels to operate a full size system. That should be in May, I believe.

Hi Desmond

I got the information and everything is ready. I have a question to Ray and George at the FCC on extending frequency ranges of licensed devices, but have not heard back. If I do not get an email from him by noon tomorrow (Tuesday), I will go ahead and take the risk and upload it to the FCC.

I know that in the past, even with Frank, the FCC could be kinda persnickety about frequency changes on grants, even on licensed devices. I know that this should be a no brainer because the only thing changed was the firmware (no circuitry in the transmitter frequency determining section was changed), but I would hate to have the grant dismissed on this technicality. But, like I said above, if I hear nothing by noon, I will complete the grant filing anyway.
