New user manual still shows metal belt clip. Please fix it.

05-22-02 Ms. Poole, I am very sorry but I am unable to find the words "metal belt clip" anywhere in the new user manual uploaded on 5/3/02.

Can you please advise where in the new user manual you found the mention of the metal belt clip?

I utilized the Find feature in Adobe Acrobat to search the document. The words "belt clip" are used in the Table of Contents, and pages 4,6 and 9 of the Adobe file, however "metal" is not mentioned.

The manual does contain simple drawings of the components/accessories for the device, and a belt clip is one of the items represented. However, there is no reference to it being metal or plastic.

One final comment is that this manual is intended for use for both the UHF model (the model under review) and a VHF model reviewed and approved previously. The VHF model does have a metal belt clip, however it was tested for SAR and found compliant.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application.
