

## USER'S MANUAL

### OPERATING INSTRUCTION FOR TME15W, TME20W, TME25W

1. USE ONLY ON 120V 60Hz CIRCUITS.
2. USE ONLY WITH A PORTABLE TABLE LAMP THAT IS PROVIDED WITH A SHADE.
3. THIS DEVICE IS NOT INTENDED FOR USE WITH EMERGENCY EXIT FIXTURES OR EMERGENCY EXIT LIGHTS.
4. NOT FOR USE ON DIMMING CIRCUITS.
5. NOT FOR USE IN TOTALLY ENCLOSED RECESSED FIXTURES.
6. USE IN DRY LOCATION ONLY.
7. INSTALL AND REMOVE LAMP FROM FIXTURE BY GRASPING PLASTIC BASE.

1. USE ONLY ON 120 VOLT, 60 HERTZ.

If INTERFERENCE SHOULD OCCUR, MOVE THE LAMP OR THE APPLIANCE INTO A DIFFERENT OUTLET.
7. TO PREVENT BURNS, DO NOT TOUCH THE BULB DURING OPERATION OR IMMEDIATELY AFTER SWITCHING OFF.
8. NOT FOR USE WITH DIMMERS, ELECTRONIC TIMER OR PHOTOCELL DEVICES OR OCCUPANCY SENSOR.
