### Getting Started

To get started, turn on your VINCI Tab MV by pressing and holding the power **ON/OFF** button for a few seconds.

Then follow the screen prompts to set up VINCI Tab MV. Visit [www.vincingenius.com](http://www.vincingenius.com) to register your VINCI Tab MV and to:

- Validate your warranty
- Obtain timely support
- Download free content

### Charging

- Connect the USB cable to the USB connector with the arrow on the cable facing the screen
- Do not bend the connector as it may damage or cause device malfunction.
- Connect the other end of the cable to the charger or to your PC. It takes about 4 hours to reach a full charge.



**Note 3:** Services are available only where your phone service is offered.



## SIM Card Installation

- Turn off the unit and open the back cover to remove the battery
- Insert the SIM card into the slot
- Install the battery and close the back cover
- 3G data SIM to be inserted in slot 1. If you use VINCI Tab MV with voice service, insert your SIM to slot 2

## Data Connection

- If your SIM card comes with WCDMA 3G services, you can get online using the wireless network. Turn on 3G data service in SIM Card Management, under Settings.

## Voice Service

- If your SIM card comes with voice service, you can make calls, send/receive SMS by enabling these services in SIM Card Management, under Settings.

## GPS

- Use the GPS app preloaded on VINCI Tab MV for location or map service.

## WIFI

- Enable WIFI by going to Settings, then turn on WIFI and follow the prompt to enter a password.

**Note:** The availability of these features depends on your cellular service plan

## USB Connection

This version supports the USB interface. You can connect your VINCI Tab MV with the PC via the USB and data cable to copy or move files, browse images and video files.

- Insert the USB data cable connector into the USB interface of VINCI Tab MV
- Connect the other terminal of the USB data cable with the USB interface of the PC

**Note:** USB connector may become damaged or malfunction if bent

# QUICK GUIDE

## VINCI Tab MV

### Web Access

- In the browser interface tap the address bar
- Insert the correct URL (e.g., [www.vincigenius.com](http://www.vincigenius.com)), then tap **Start**

### Install New Content

VINCI Curriculum MicroSD cards do NOT work with VINCI Tab MV. After Parent Login, you may install new apps through WIFI. **VINCI Curriculum** apps can be downloaded by visiting [curriculum.vincigenius.com](http://curriculum.vincigenius.com). You may also install additional **VINCI Kids Library** titles from [kidslibrary.vincigenius.com](http://kidslibrary.vincigenius.com).

**WARNING:** The inside of your VINCI Tab MV contains fragile components. Do not twist, disassemble or drop from a high place or onto a hard surface. Avoid extreme heat and do not submerge in water.



### Safety Precautions & Warranty

#### Warning:

- Do not use VINCI Tab MV while charging
- Make sure the MicroUSB connector is positioned correctly to ensure proper charging
- Do not use liquids, chemicals or detergents to clean VINCI Tab MV. Only use a dry, lint-free cloth

#### Return & Warranty:

### Carrying Your Tab

When you are using the Tab, keep it at some distance (at least 2.5 cm away from your body). In case there is a need of slipcover, belt clip, or other accessories to carry your Tab, it is important to ensure these accessories are approved by the manufacturer. Otherwise, it may exceed the upper limit of radio frequency leakage.

### Energy Leak of Radio Frequency

VINCI Tab MV is a low-power, wireless transmitter and receiver. After being powered on, it will periodically send and receive radio signals while

its transmission power is controlled by the network. This device complies with local standards restricting energy leak of radio frequency.

### Electromagnetic Radiation

VINCI Tab MV fully complies with standards related to wireless irradiation enacted by the authority of the State and International Health Association. These limitations are part of the comprehensive regulations and constitute public wireless irradiation permission standards. These standards are developed and formed after long-term intensive scientific research by independent scientific organizations such as International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection (ICNIRP). These standards contain a large surplus to ensure the safety of all and take the variable factors of various measurement conditions into consideration.

**FCC Statement:** This device has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation.
