INSTRUCTION MANUAL

- Bluetooth 2.0 with supported profile A2DP
- No battery required, powered up when insert to the connector of the iDocking speaker
- Reception range up to 10 metres (33 feet)
- Easy pairing & play wireless music from A2DP equipped device



Operation of the unit:

- Insert the unit to the connector of iDocking speaker & make sure in iPod mode
- Press & hold the POWER button (3 second) to turn on the unit
- * start pairing, LED blinking quick and emit tone sound
- * BD-100 appears on the device list of your Bluetooth device
- * select the BD-100 (if a pass code is requested, enter 0000)
- * pairing completed, LED blinking slow
- Playback the music from your device, enjoy the wireless music from the iDocking speaker
- Press & hold the POWER button (3 second) to turn off the unit
