Subj: Request that materials submitted to the Commission be withheld from public inspection

To Whom it May Concern:

Microgistics, Inc. (Grantee Code OG2) has submitted a request for equipment authorization to the commission for its WalkMate transmitter. The FCC ID for this grant is OG2WALKMATE, the Form 731 confirmation number is EA93484.

Microgistics respectfully requests that the following materials submitted with the request for equipment authorization be withheld from public inspection per 47 CFR Ch. 1 Section 0.459(a) and (b):

1. WalkMate Operational Description.doc
2. WalkMate Schematic.doc
3. WalkMate Block Diagram.jpg
4. WalkMate Internal Photos.doc

Each of these documents contains significant amounts of information about the design or operation of the WalkMate transmitter which is considered proprietary and confidential by Microgistics. This information could be used by competitors of Microgistics to replicate proprietary elements of the WalkMate design which would significantly degrade Microgistics' competitive advantage in the marketplace.

Microgistics does not share this information with any other entities unless a Confidential Disclosure Agreement is in place between the parties. Standard agreements of this type require that each of the parties hold the information confidential for a period of 5 years. Some agreements require confidentiality in perpetuity.
