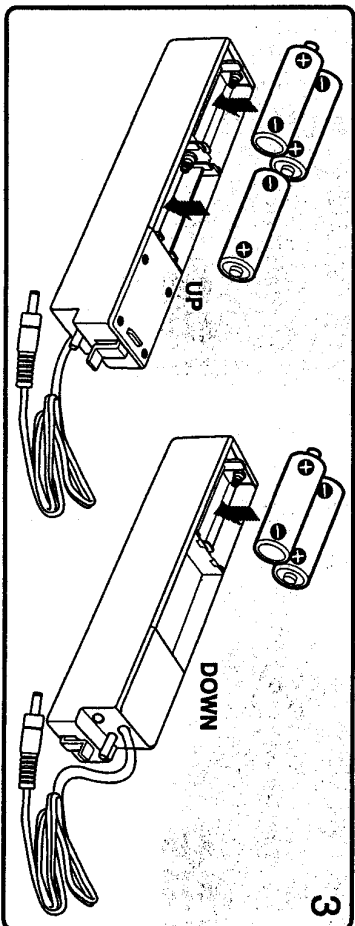
BATTERY CHARGER INSTALLATION:



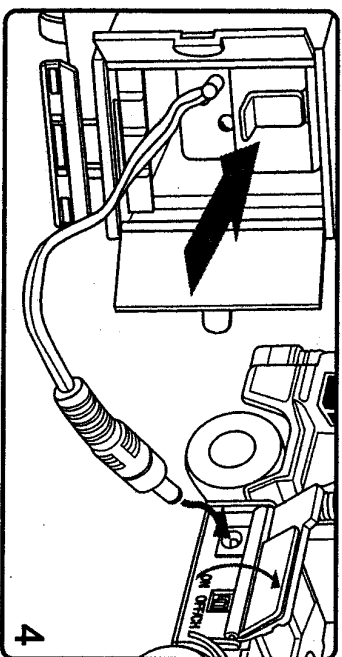
1. Open Trailer Back Door and pull the Cord and Plug out that connects to the battery Charger.



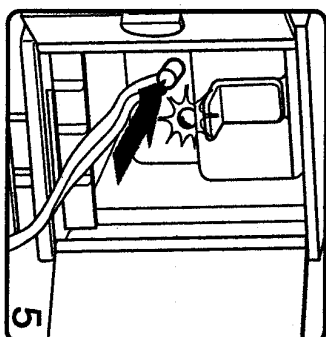
2. Press the Lock Button of the Battery Charger Cassette and pull it out from the Trailer.



3. Install 5 pcs Batteries in the Cassette as indicated. Follow the Positive (+) and Negative (-) Polarity as indicated on the Cassette.



4a. Slide the Battery Charger Cassette back to the Trailer until you hear a 'Click' sound that indicates the Cassette is locked in the Trailer.
4b. Turn the switch on the Cab to 'OFF/CH' mode.
4c. Insert the Plug into the Socket on the Cab.

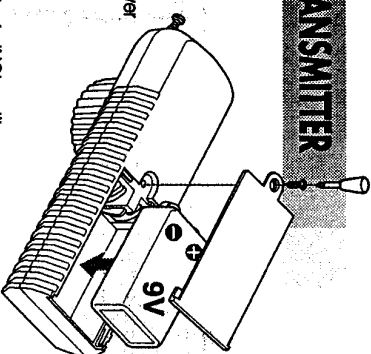


5a. Press the Charger Button on the Battery Charger Cassette then the Charger starts charging the Cab and while it is charging, the Red Lights start blinking. When the Cab is fully charged, the Red Light will go off. (About 5 minutes)
5b. Remove the Plug from the Socket and store it back to the Trailer.
5c. Turn the Switch on the Cab to 'ON' mode then you can start playing.
5d. After playing, turn the switch on the Cab to OFF/CH mode to avoid drainage of battery.

BATTERY INSTALLATION FOR TRANSMITTER

TRANSMITTER BATTERY INSTALLATION:

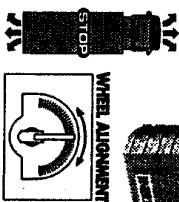
- Insert 9V battery into the battery compartment. Make sure the ends of the batteries positive (+) and negative (-) match the markings on the battery compartment. This is most important.
- Close and tighten the back plate with a Phillips screwdriver and remove battery for storage when not in use.



HOW TO OPERATED:

1. Turn ON/OFF switches on left side of cab and transmitter to 'NO' position.
2. Extend transmitter antenna to full length when in use.

- 3) FORWARD/REVERSE BUTTON
 - Push Button up to Forward mode for forward, headlights will light up as vehicle goes forward. Push Button down to Reverse Mode for Reverse direction.
 - After playing, turn the switch to OFF mode to avoid drainage of battery.
- 4) STEERING KNOB
 - Turn the Steering Knob to anti-clockwise direction for turning left and clockwise direction for turning right. The triangular lights on the top of the knob will light up to indicate the direction.
- 5) RELEASE BUTTON
 - Press the Release Button once to release the Cab from the Trailer, the Cab will detach from the Trailer and move forward at the same time.
 - On undusted surfaces, you may press this button once more if the Cab did not release from the Trailer at the first press.
 - Change the 9V battery in the Transmitter if it does not function properly.



SWITCH THE DIRECTION TRAINER IF THE CAR DOES NOT RUN STRAIGHT. TURN IT TO LEFT OR RIGHT UNTIL YOUR DESIRED ALIGNMENT IS REACHED.
