Mr. Lyles,

We've received your latest correspondence with the following guidance:

1) Modify the Contention Based protocol Guidance letter to explain the firmware modification. "Modify firmware to establish an indefinite back-off window that will expire only if the contention window measurement results in an inactive channel. We will no longer allow expiration of the back-off window ("Intervention timer") to take priority over the threshold detector. In other words, we will NOT transmit if channel monitoring (in every frame) indicates an active channel." 2) Then upload this as an exhibit into the operational description as the Contention Based protocol description.

Accordingly the CBP Guidance letter has been revised and a new CBP exhibit has been uploaded to the FCC website.

Textual updates are found primarily at the end of section 2.1, with associated updates for consistency sake found in sections 2.3.1, 2.3.3, 2.4.5, and 2.4.6

We trust this will satisfy your prior concern.
