



Frank, recently the FAA has received notification of requests for FCC equipment authorization (certification) by three companies. We request that the FCC withhold final approval until we have had sufficient time to complete our review of the equipment and notify you of our decision. The first notification was from E-ROCK, International Corporation. They would like certification for a Luggage Locator system. The FCC ID for the transmitter is OMWTL168T and the receiver is OMWTL168R. The second notification came from Rockwell Collins, Inc. for the SRT-2000 INMARSAT AERO-I transceiver. The FCC ID is AJK8221349. The third notification was from Becker Avionics System for an airborne communications transceiver. The FCC ID is B54RT320911.
