### Volume control

When the phone calling, use the direction keys of the UP and Down keys to adjust the volume. When listening to the radio or music, with \* and # keys to adjust the volume.

This mobile phone supports multi-language inputs, providing you with multiple input methods: letter input, numeric input, symbol input, etc. . Changing the input method

### Press "#" key repeatedly to select an input method.

Inserting symbols

Press "\*" key and select the required symbols.

## Numeric

When the input method icon is shown as "123", input numbers directly with number keys

Note: While using the numeric input method, you need to switch to other text input methods to insert a space by pressing number key 0.

The specific operations of such input methods are describes as below: Multitap ABC and abc

Press a number key (2-9) repeatedly until the required letter appears in the text. Press a key once to input the first letter listed on the key, press it twice quickly to input the second letter, and so on. Press number key 0 to insert a space. Press number key 0 twice to enter 0. While entering text. press the right soft key (Clear) once to delete the last character on the display; press and hold it to delete all entered text. Smart ABC and abc Press each key associated with the letter you want to enter only once. The letters you have entered appear at the bottom of screen. The candidate words change with each key you press. When the candidate words are displayed, press the direction keys to choose words. While entering text, press the right soft key (Clear) once to delete the last character on the

### Switching on/off phone

Press and hold "Power on/ off" key to switch on (or switch off) the mobile phone. If phone power on without SIM card, the two situations will

"Insert SIM" - indicates no SIM card found, but emergency call is available. "Enter Phone Lock Code" - indicates that you have set mobile phone lock. After inserting SIM card, the handset will

display; press and hold it to delete all entered text.

### Entering Numbers

In the "123" input mode, press a key labeled the desired number. In the "ABC" or "abc" input mode, press a numeric key repeatedly until the desired number appears on the screen.

## **Entering Symbols**

To any input modes, press \* key to display a symbol list.

### Functional MenusPhonebook

The phone provides two kinds of storage media: SIM card and phone. The phone can store 200 entries. The capacity of the phone book on your SIM card depends on the type of SIM card provided by your network operator. Enter a number in standby mode and press the left soft key or the OK key to save the number. Select the storage location. Then the edit interface appears. If To SIM1 or To SIM2 is selected, you need to edit the number only. If To phone is selected, you need to edit the items that you set in the settings of phone book, including the name, number, home number, company name, email address, office number, fax number, birthday caller group. In standby mode, press the right soft key to directly access the phone book.

#### Quick search

In standby mode, press right soft key to go to phonebook, and select guick search to go to the interface view the phonebook. If you insert dual SIM cards, the numbers include phone, SIM1 card and SIM2 card, Enter the first letter. Then all the records starting with such letter are displayed

#### Search contact

Search the phonebook record according to name entered.

#### Add new contact

In standby mode, input the phone number directly. Press left soft key to save current number either in phone or SIM card. Then input the name or related information. Finally, confirm the operation according to the prompts.

■ When inputting wrong number, name or other related information, press right soft key to delete the character before the cursor.

automatically check if the SIM is valid. Then, the following prompts will be displayed in order on the screen.

- 1. "Enter Phone Lock Code" in this case you have set mobile phone lock.
- 2. "Enter PIN" in this case you have set SIM password.
- 3. "Invalid SIM" in this case phone is not registered on correct network. you can only dial emergency number.
- 4. "Searching" mobile phone will search until proper network access is found.

### SIM Card Installation

Before your can operate the mobile phone, you should get a valid SIM card from the service operator, otherwise, you could not make any call except emergency call; When you need to remove the SIM card, please shutdown, take out the battery then remove the SIM card from the card slot. This mobile phone supports dual SIM cards and works with one or two SIM cards installed. The SIM card installation method: Power off the phone; remove battery, then insert SIM card into SIM card socket. When you need to remove SIM card, please power off the phone first, remove battery, then remove the card.

#### Memory Card Installation

This mobile phone supports T-Flash card, which is a small memory card used to increase the memory of your mobile phone. Take care when as Sembling or disassembling to avoid any damage.

#### Please refer to the installation of SIM for installation of memory card. Use earphone

When you plug earphone into the phone's headset jack, the phone's profile will automatically switch to headset profile. The phone can use regular headphones, through the automatic answer, you can listen to music through headphones or receive calls.

### Safety Password

PIN1 Code is the Personal Identification Number for entering a SIM card. 'Input PIN' is requested each time the phone is switched

>Short press: delete last character before the cursor.

>Long press: delete all characters.

For inputting names and other related information, refer to chapter 4.2 "input text".

Copy the records from SIM1 to phone, from phone to SIM1, from SIM2 to phone, from phone to SIM2, from SIM1 to SIM2, and from SIM2 to SIM1.

You can choose to delete all the records from the SIM1 card. SIM2 card or phone, or delete them one by one.

Note: If you want to delete all records at once, the phone password is required, which is "1234" by default,

#### Caller groups

A caller group is the combination of phone settings used to identify a particular group of records. The phone provides five call groups: Friends. Family, VIP, Business and Others, You can manage and edit the details of caller groups.

### Extra numbers

Set the SIM1 owner number and SIM2 owner number, SIM1 service dialing number and SIM2 service dialing number, SIM1 SOS number and SIM2 SOS number

- Memory Status: Check the storage capacity of the SIM card and nhonehook
- Preferred storage: Select the storage location for the phonebook
- Fields: You can select individual item according to your needs (this function is limited to the contact saving at the handset).

The phone supports Short Messaging Service (SMS). You can send text messages and manage the messages that you sent and received. on if this PIN1 code is activated.

You can get PIN1 Code with the SIM card by your network operator. It usually has 4 digits. When you input the PIN1 Code, '\*' will display on the main screen instead of the digits.

## PIN2 code

PIN2 is required for some specific functions provided by the network. such as the charge information.

Note: If you enter the PIN incorrectly three times in a row, the SIM card will be locked. Please contact your network operator immediately for decoding. Attempting to decode by yourself may result in the permanent failure of the SIM card.

## PUK code

PUK (Personal Unblocking Key, 8-digit) unlocks a locked PIN. If you enter the PUK incorrectly ten times in a row, the SIM card will become invalid. Please contact your network operator for a new SIM card. Mobile phone password

The phone lock protects your phone from unauthorized use. The default phone lock code is 0000. You can change it into any numeric string of 4 to 8 digits. If the phone lock function is enabled, you need to enter the correct phone lock code when the phone is powered on or in the standby mode.

## Quick Use Guide

The information scales displayed on the upper left screen indicate the intensity of network signal (of which 5 scales appeared indicating the strongest signal). ## Answering a call

When a call comes in, it enters into the phone-in screen, alerting you with presetting ringing tone or vibration. > If the number does not exist in the phonebook, the caller's number

appears. Otherwise, his/her name appears. >Key operation

#### Left soft key: answer a call, dial key, answer a call:

>Right soft call: reject, H-Free, H-Held. Missed Call

In standby mode, press the left soft key to go to the main menu, and then select the call center to view the call log.

In standby mode, press the calling key to directly access the call logs of the SIM card.

Call center include the following sub-menus: Call history and General call settings.

In the SIM1 call history, you can carry out the following operations: >SIM1 Missed Calls: record the number of missed calls.

SIM1 Dialed Calls: record the number of dialed numbers. >SIM1 Received Calls: record the number of received calls.

>Delete SIM1 Call Log: delete the record of missed calls, or dialed calls, or received calls.

>SIM1 Call Time: record of the period of last call, total calls, etc >SIM1 Call Cost: calculate the cost of the last call, total calls, etc >SIM1 SMS Counter: record the number of sent messages and

received messages.

## **Dual SIM settings**

There are 4 options in of SIM settings: Dual SIM open: Only SIM1 open: Only SIM2 open: Flight mode.

When you are on a flight where the use of mobile phones is prohibited, select flight mode so that the phone will not connect to any network. However, alarm and calendar reminder will remain on. You can still use the entertainment features such as audio player and camera in Flight mode.

## Phone setup

In Phone Setup, you may set functions, such as the language, time and date, according to your preferences and operation habits. You can See the following setting options in the phone setting interface:

■ Time and Date: You can set city, time and display format.

■ Schedule Power ON/Off: The mobile phone provides 4 times for Scheduled power on and off. You can set status and time for each Scheduled time

>Note: Please ensure the automatic power on function has been deactivate when you are in a place that forbids the use of mobile phone (like in an aircraft for instance) to avoid accidents.

Language: Set current display language.

## Network setup

It requires network support

The network that your phone uses is configured automatically. When turned on, the phone automatically connects to the designated network. Or automatically connects to a roaming network when you are outside the coverage of your regular network. When outside the coverage of your regular network, you can manually select the local network system.

■ Network Selection. Start new search of the network: Select the Etwork; Select auto or manual to search network.

■ Preferred networks: Set priority network.

#### Security setup

The security setting helps to protect your phone against unauthorized use or restrict the phone use by setting, modifying various pins and options. The default pin is 1234. Also, the user can choose the time to Unlock the phone lock or pin lock

### ■ SIM security setup:

♦SIM lock: The SIM1 card is protected against misuse by the PIN code. SIM1 card lock may be set after you enter the PIN code correctly. During setup, it is required to input the correct PIN code. If wrong codes are inputted for three times, the

### Bluetooth

You can connect wirelessly to other compatible devices with wireless Bluetooth technology. Compatible devices may include mobile phones. computers and enhancements such as headsets and car kits. You can use Bluetooth connectivity to send images, video clips, music, sound clips and notes. Since devices with Bluetooth wireless technology communicate by radio waves, your device and the other device do not need to be in direct line-of-sight. The two devices only need to be within 10 meters (33 feet) of each other, but the connection may be subject to the interference from obstructions such as walls or other electronic devices.

>Power: Activate or deactivate mobile phone's Bluetooth headset.

>Inquiry audio device: After the function is selected, the mobile phone will automatically search Bluetooth headset or other equipments which is nearby (about 10 meters).

>My device: Displayed my all device list: Bluetooth headset, equipment,

>Active Device: Displays Bluetooth setting after connected. >Settings: Carry out such related settings as visibility, change device name, authentication, audio path etc.

♦Visibility: allow or disallow others to search your mobile phone via Bluetooth.

♦ Change device name: Edit phone Bluetooth's name.

Audio Path: Set 'Leave in phone' or 'Forward to BT headset' setting. ♦Storage: Choose to access location.

About: Displayed mobile phone's Bluetooth equipments related information.

### This mobile phone offers WAP that allows you to access the mobile phone Internet.

You should register for an authentication from the network operator and input the right parameters provided by network operator before using this function. ♦Homepage: Connect browser to a homepage you set.

♦Bookmarks: bookmark your favorite WAP sites or edit the bookmarks Recent pages: The phone displays the recently-visited pages.

♦Input address: Allows you to access WAP page directly by entering the URL ♦Service inbox: This function means the service provider will send WAP content

to your phone without any operation from you. For example, you can obtain the latest news or new WAP setting from the service provider.

>PUK (Personal Unlock code) will be required. PUK is used to unlock and change the locked PIN code. If PUK code is not provided or missed, please contact your local network service provider

♦Fixed dial: You can define a list of numbers that can be dialed by SIM1. Numbers not included in this list cannot be dialed by SIM1. Note: The SIM1 PIN2 code is required. Once the PIN2 code is entered when the phone is turned on, it is no longer required until next time the phone is turned on.

♦Barred dial: It requires network support. If the SIM card supports this function, you may restrict the numbers for outgoing calls. If activated, your phone may not call the numbers in the fixed dial list. The PIN2 code is required for this setting. ♦ Change password: Set new passwords, including SIM1 PIN and

SIM1 PIN2. ■ Phone Lock: If the phone lock is activated, the phone lock password is requested after the phone is switched on. The default
