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GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The **Sounding Audio Industrial Ltd.**'s product, model number: **VRCP-65 (FCC ID: OPDVRCP65)** (the "EUT") in this report was a **2DIN Car Audio with CarPlay**, which was measured approximately: 8.5 cm (L) x 18.8 cm (W) x 11.7 cm (H), rated input voltage: DC12V.

Note: The series product, model VRCP-65, PDCP-62 are electrically identical, the differences between them are the model name and brand, we selected VRCP-65 for fully testing, the details was explained in the attached declaration letter.

**All measurement and test data in this report was gathered from final production sample, serial number: 170504005 (assigned by the BACL, Chengdu). It may have deviation from any other sample. The EUT supplied by the applicant was received on 2017-05-04, and EUT conformed to test requirement.*

Objective

This report is prepared on behalf of **Sounding Audio Industrial Ltd.** in accordance with Part 2, Subpart J, Part 15, Subparts A and C of the Federal Communications Commission's rules

The tests were performed in order to determine the Bluetooth BDR and EDR mode of EUT compliance with FCC Rules Part 15, Subpart C, and section 15.203, 15.205, 15.209 and 15.247 rules.

Test Methodology

All measurements detailed in this Test Report were performed in accordance with ANSI C63.10-2013 "American National Standard of Procedures for Compliance Testing of Unlicensed Wireless Devices".

All of the measurements detailed in this Test Report were performed by Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Chengdu).

The Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. Chengdu's measurement Uncertainties (calculated for a k=2 Coverage Factor corresponding to approximately 95% Coverage) were as follows:

-For all of the AC Line Conducted Emissions Tests reported herein: ± 3.17 dB.

-For of all of the Direct Antenna Conducted Emissions Tests reported herein: ± 0.56 dB.

-For of all of the direct Radiated Emissions Tests reported herein are:

30 MHz to 200 MHz: ± 4.7 dB;

200 MHz to 1 GHz: ± 6.0 dB;

1 GHz to 6 GHz: ± 5.13 dB; and,

6 GHz to 40 GHz: ± 5.47 dB.

And the uncertainty will not be taken into consideration for all test data recorded in the report.

Test Facility

The test site used by BACL to collect test data is located in the No.5040, Huilongwan Plaza, No.1, Shawan Road, Jinniu District, Chengdu, Sichuan, China.

Test site at BACL has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). The details of these reports have been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on April 24, 2015. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4-2014.

The Federal Communications Commission has the reports on file and is listed under FCC Registration No.: 560332. The test site has been approved by the FCC for public use and is listed in the FCC Public Access Link (PAL) database.

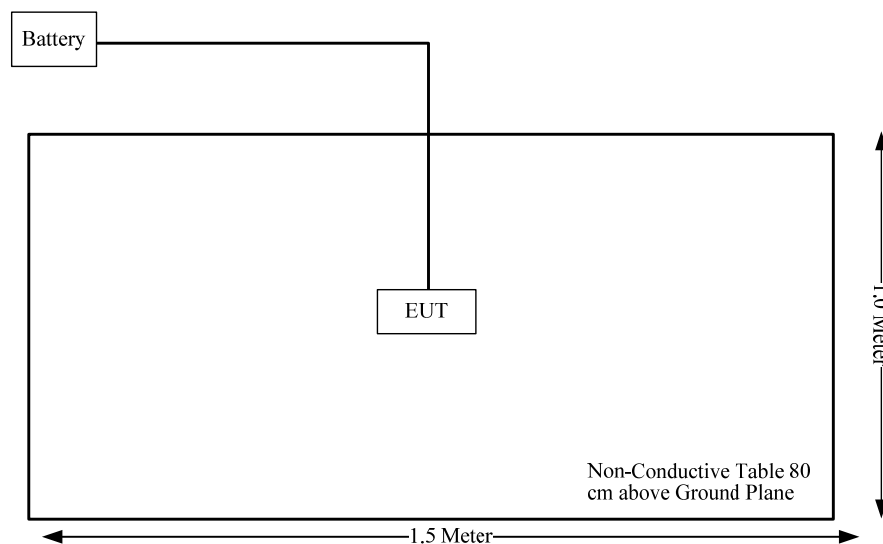

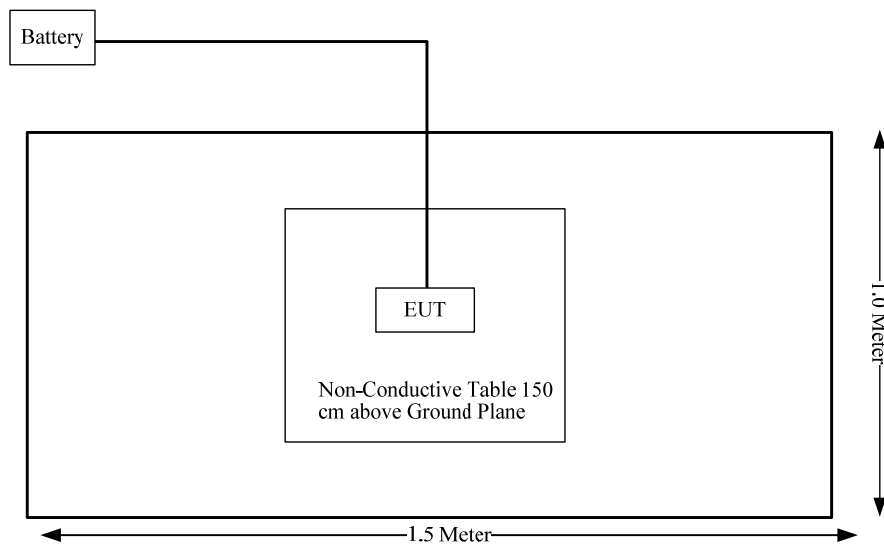

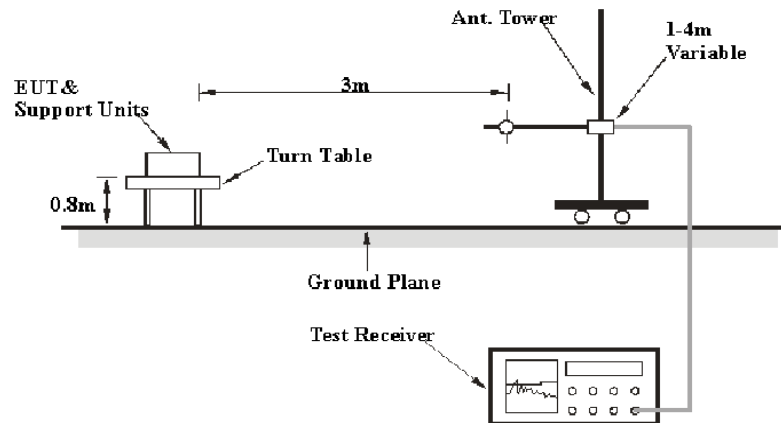

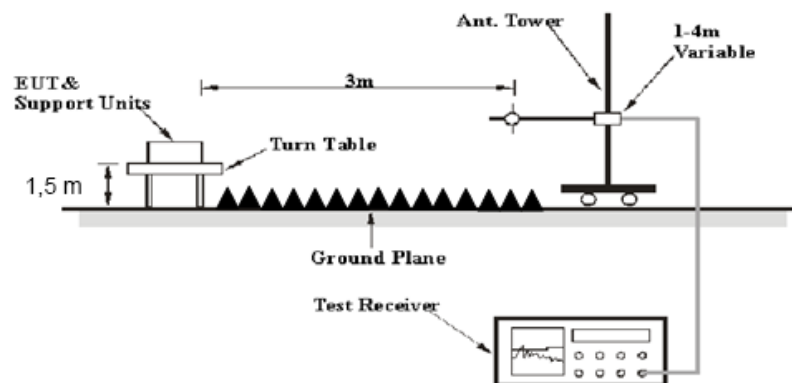

The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters chamber test site, using the setup accordance with the ANSI C63.10-2013. The specification used was the FCC 15.209, and FCC 15.247 limits.

The external I/O cables were draped along the test table and formed a bundle 30 to 40 cm long in the middle.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

EMI Test Receiver & Spectrum Analyzer Setup

The system was investigated from 30 MHz to 25 GHz.

During the radiated emission test, the EMI test receiver & Spectrum Analyzer Setup were set with the following configurations:

Test Procedure

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

Data was recorded in Quasi-peak detection mode for frequency range of 30 MHz - 1 GHz, peak and average detection modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.

Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The Corrected Amplitude is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Loss, and subtracting the Amplifier Gain from the Meter Reading. The basic equation is as follows:

$$\text{Corrected Amplitude} = \text{Meter Reading} + \text{Antenna Factor} + \text{Cable Loss} - \text{Amplifier Gain}$$

The “**Margin**” column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance with the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:

$$\text{Margin} = \text{Limit} - \text{Corrected Amplitude}$$

Frequency hopping systems shall have hopping channel carrier frequencies separated by a minimum of 25 kHz or the 20dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater. Alternatively, frequency hopping systems operating in the 2400-2483.50 MHz band may have hopping channel carrier frequencies that are separated by 25 kHz or two-thirds of the 20dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater provided the systems operate with an output power no greater than 125 mW.
