PREAMBLE

The BREITLING EMERGENCY is an instrument consisting of two distinct and independent elements :

- A BREITLING electronic chronograph
- A single-frequency micro-transmitter broadcasting a pulse signal. Made by *Dassault Automatismes et Télécommunications*.

BREITLING produces the complete instrument.

In its current civilian version, the EMERGENCY's transmitter broadcasts on the aviation distress frequency of 121.5 MHz in the VHF (Very High Frequency) band.

Other specialized and military versions using other frequencies may be commissioned according to particular technical specifications, sales or service conditions that are not detailed in this document.



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
