Confidentiality Request regarding application for certification of Vecima TRX2525Y
2.5-2.6 GHz Broadband Wireless Transceiver, **FCC ID: OPPTRX2525Y**

Pursuant to Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, we hereby request
confidential treatment of information accompanying this application as outlined below:

Schematic Diagrams, Block Diagrams, Parts Lists, Tune-up Procedures

We have requested that the information listed above required to be submitted with this
application be withheld from public review.

Reason for request:

This information is a trade secret. Vecima Networks Inc. developed the TRX2525Y
product in response to commercial marketplace requirements. Its design and functional
features are exclusive to Vecima Networks.

The TRX2525Y product is offered in the highly competitive Point-to-Multi-Point Fixed
Broadband Wireless service market. Technology in the field of wireless communications
is evolving rapidly, and confidentiality of proprietary design information is essential to
maintain competitiveness in this market. Disclosure of this information may allow
competitors to benefit from Vecima Networks' intellectual property.

All employees of Vecima Networks Inc. are required to sign an Intellectual Property
Agreement form upon becoming employed with Vecima Networks. This will identify the
responsibility and rights of both Vecima Networks and the employee in regard to any
interest or rights involved in the discoveries, inventions, improvements, etc. normally
referred to as "Inventions" which are made by the employee during the course of his/her
work.

All OEM manufacturing partners, as well as any visitors to the plant, are required to sign
non-disclosure agreements prior to being granted access to production and
research/development areas. Electronic originals of proprietary documents are password
protected and hardcopies are controlled.

This information is not available to the public and there have been no disclosures to
parties who are not employees of Vecima Networks with the exception of Bay Area
Compliance Lab Corp., who is acting on our behalf as an agent to FCC.

The period of time required for nondisclosure for the TRX2525Y product is for the life of the product (typically 20 years) and beyond, since features of the current design may be incorporated in future Vecima Networks products. This period should therefore be 20 years.


The TRX2525Y product cannot be readily reverse-engineered without the schematics and parts lists. The TRX2525Y incorporates proprietary software embedded in its circuits that is essential for its operation.

The TRX2525Y is not sold directly to the general public; it is sold only to known, approved customers after credit check. No units are sold to known or potential competitors where there may be a possibility of reverse engineering. The TRX2525Y requires professional installation.

The applicant understands that pursuant to Section 0.457 of the Rules, disclosure of this application and all accompanying documentation will not be made before the date of the Grant for this application.
