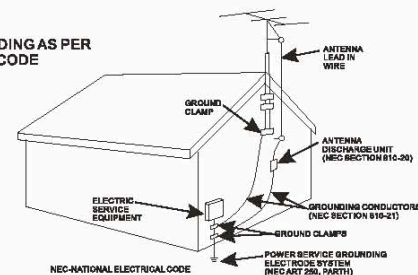

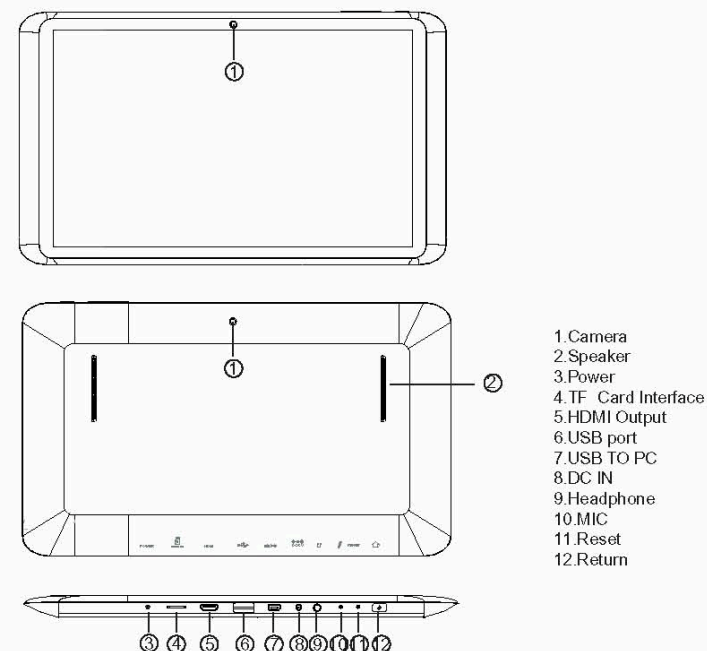

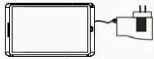
## Getting Started

### Battery Recharge

The device built-in DC 3.7V, 5000 mAh rechargeable Lithium-ion Polymer battery.

Recharge as follows:

- Insert the small plug from the supplied AC/DC Adaptor to the DC IN jack on the device. Plug the AC/DC Adaptor to wall outlet having AC 100-240V~, 50/60 Hz.



This power unit is intended to be in a vertical or floor mount position.

Notes: Your battery will last longer if you follow these simple guidelines for caring for and storing it.

- Using the supplied AC/DC Adaptor for charging only. Other models charger may damage the device.
- For charging first time, charge it approximate 10 hours. For normal charging, it needs approximately 4 hours.
- Recharge and store the device within the temperature range of 5°C~35°C (40°F~95°F).
- Do not overcharge (longer than 24 hours). Excessive charging or running the unit until battery goes empty will damage battery. Battery life will be extended if you keep the battery fully charge.
- Battery life naturally shortens slowly over time.
- The rechargeable battery incorporated in this product is not user replaceable.

### Using the touch screen

Tap/press the corresponding button on the touch screen with your fingertip or the supplied Touch Screen Pen (on the rear of cabinet).


Touch the screen and slide from Right to Left; Left to Right to scroll the pages.

Notes:

- Do not use force when touching the touch screen, as it may cause damage to the screen.
- To avoid damage to the touch screen, do not use any object other than your fingers or the supplied Touch Screen Pen to operate it.
- Do not tap/press on the touch screen if your fingers are not clean.
- Do not tap/press on the touch screen with gloves on.

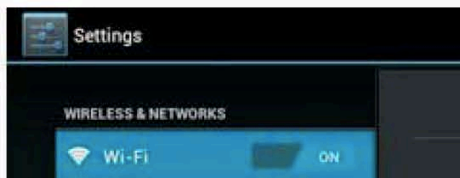
**Turn the device on** Press the power button and hold for 3 seconds.

Wi-Fi set up: Set up and manage WiFi access points.



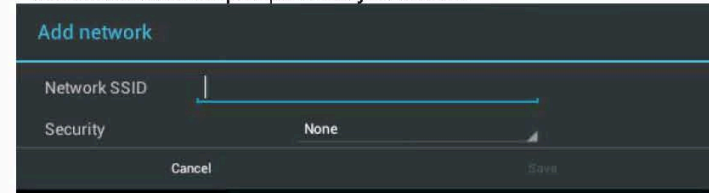

## Touch Screen Operation

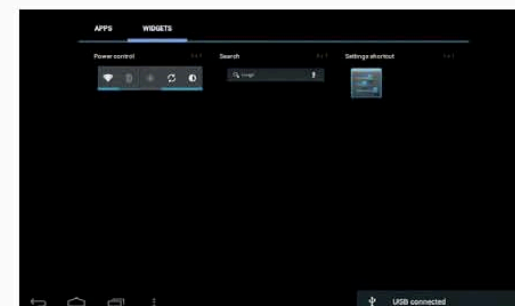
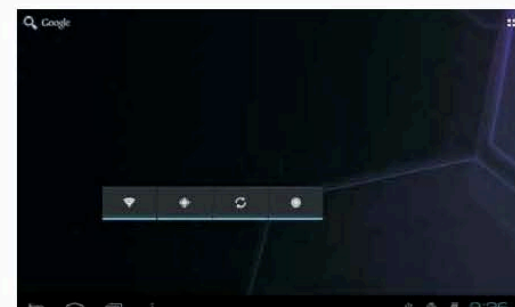
Size of this tablet touch screen is 10.1". Below are some advise of how to operate the touch zone:

" button, there will be a lot of application widget icon , you can select the icon which will appear in the home page as the shortcut. You will quickly get to the program.





### Downloading Android Applications

- 2 Tap the  **Explorer** application icon.
- 3 Tap  or  and locate the folder in which the .apk application files were saved.
- 4 Tap on a .apk file → **Install**.  
The application is installed and the application icon is added to the **Applications** screen.
- 5 Tap **Open** to launch the application now, or tap **Done** to return to the **File Browser** screen.

## Downloading Android Applications direct from a Website

You can download Android applications directly from websites, and then quickly and easily install them on your device.

- 1 Tap the  **Web** application icon to launch the internet browser.
- 2 Enter the desired website URL, and tap the **download** link for the application you want to install on your device.
- 3 After the download is complete, touch & hold on the download file (in the **Download history** screen), → tap **Open** → **Install**.

## Uninstalling Android Applications

You can also quickly and easily uninstall the Android applications that you have installed.

- 1 Tap  → **Settings** → **Applications** → **Manage applications**.
- 2 Tap the application you want to uninstall, → **Uninstall**.
- 3 Tap **OK** to confirm the Uninstall.

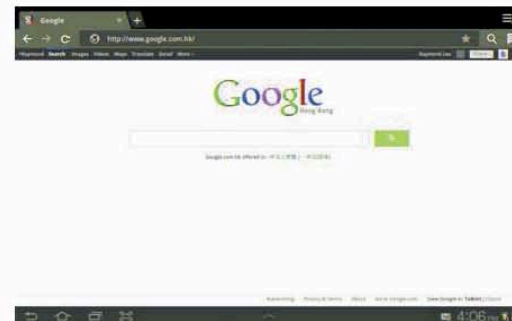


A 3<sup>rd</sup> party application such as Skype can be downloaded from app stores such as Getjar and Amazon APP store.

### Take Videos

### Email

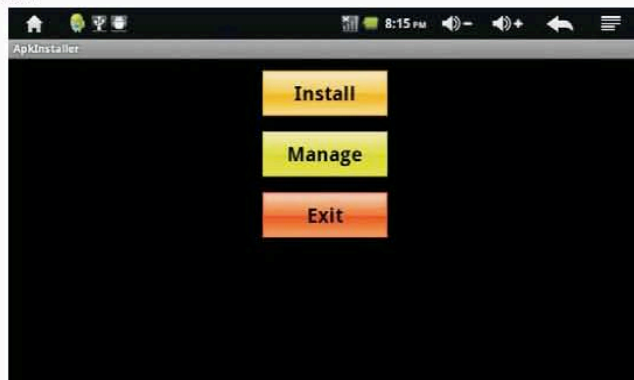
Inside the apps menu, tap the icon  to enter the 'Email' client. It's required to config the account information for the first time. Pre-register and set up your email account is necessary. Please be advised that Gmail ACCOUNT registration is necessary in order to access services provided by Google and Android System.

### APK Software Installation and Management

#### APK Installer (Application Installer)

This device supports third party applications on the basis of android platform. Most of the applications can be downloaded from the websites via the internet, and copied into the internal flash or Micro SD card of this device.

- Tap the icon of Apkinstaller  on the sub-menu page. The following will appear on the screen:

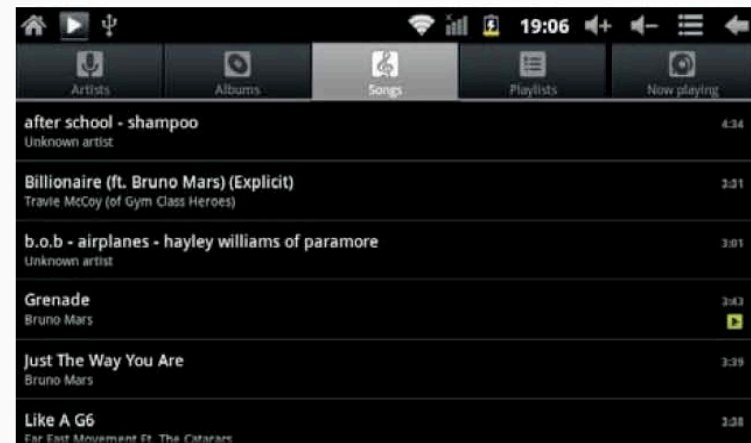


- Installation:
  - Tap the "Install" button, the memory location list will appear on the screen.
  - Select and tap where your APK file is located, either Internal memory or external SD Card. The files list will appear on the screen.
  - Select and tap into the file to install the file onto your device.
- Select and Tap the "Manage" button for Installed application management. Select and tap the application being shown on the screen for Launch, Export, uninstall and cancel.
- Select and tap "Exit" to exit.

### Play MUSIC

☆ Audio file formats supported: MP1, MP2, [MP3](#), WMA, OGG, APE, FLAC, WAV, AC3, AAC, AMR, DTS, RA, M4A.

When no music files in the audio player playlist, the system will automatically load the music files from the card to the audio player playlist after turning on the audio player .The playlist as shown in the above figure:



You can pass the audio files by the way of synchronous USB, or access to audio files by inserting the SD card which it is already full of audio files. You can also download the audio file through the network.

Select the appropriate tab key, you can see for example "Artist", "album", "songs" and other interfaces. Select a song to play.



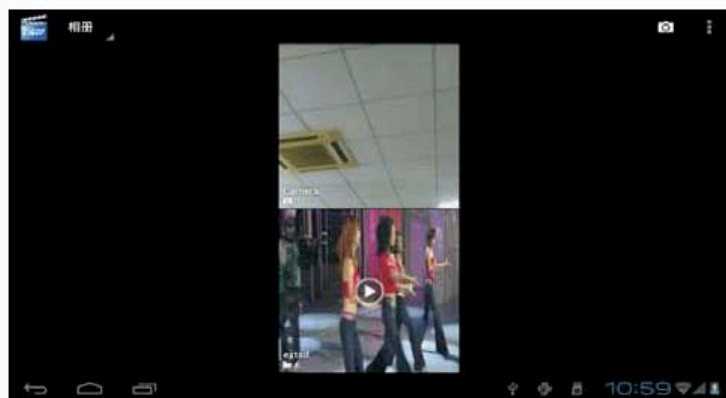

**Q: Do I have to charge the battery before use?**

A: You should charge the battery for at least 4 hours, but you can use the device while it's charging. Use the include power adapter to charge; this device charge via USB cable.
