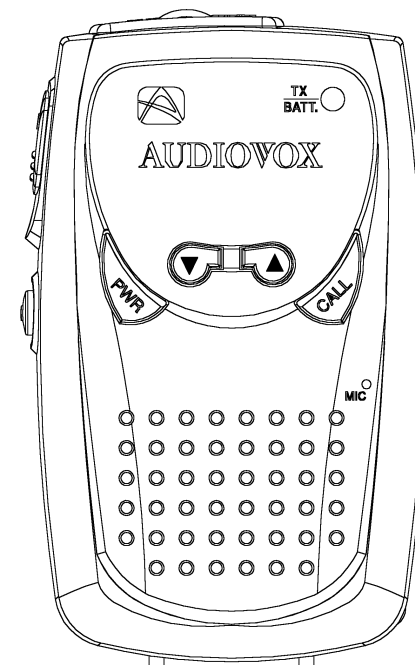

Your transceiver will achieve its maximum operating range when communicating with other transceiver(s) in a flat open area with no trees or buildings obstructing its signal. Range may be up to two miles under such conditions. Obstacles such as buildings, trees or mountains will tend to reduce the transceiver's effective range.

◆ OPERATION

Low Battery Indication

- ▶ When the battery is low, RX/BATT. LED Lamp will flash to indicate that the batteries need to be replaced.

Sending Call Toned

You can use Call Tones to alert the other user or to identify yourself.

You can also use Call Tones to signal the beginning or the end of transmission.

1. Press and release the CALL button.
2. Your Call Tones will transmit.

Accessory Connection

FR530-2 model is designed to work with various accessories.

When those accessories are connected through ACCESSORY CONNECTOR, the headphone symbol will display on LCD indicating FR530-2 is operating with accessories.

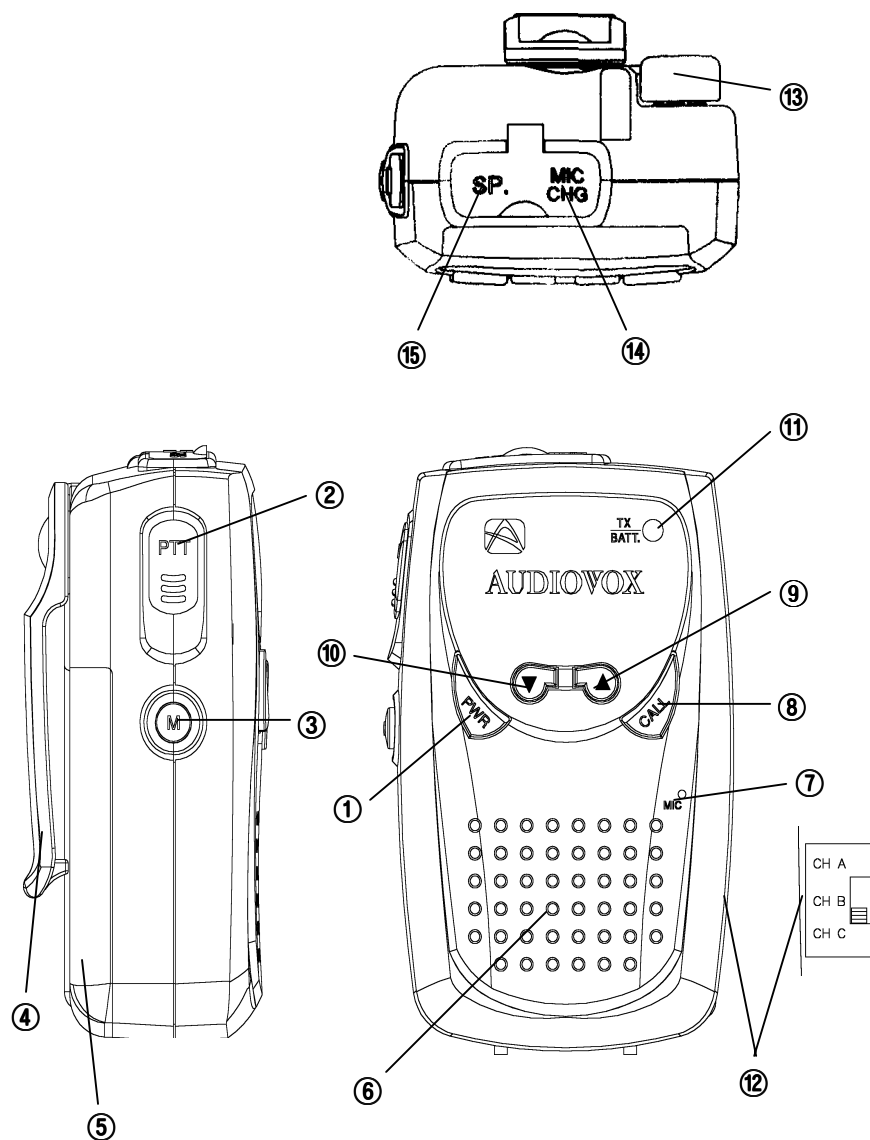
Accessories Available

The following accessories work with FR530-2.

- Charging Kit
(NI-MH Rechargeable Batteries and AC/DC Adapter)
- Speaker Microphone with Lapel Clip
- VOX Headset
- Neck Strap
- Carrying Case

1. **Power Button** : *Press* and *hold* this button for 2 seconds to turn the transceiver on or off
2. **PTT(Push-To-Talk) Button** : *Press* and *hold* to transmit. Release to receive.
3. **Monitor Button** : *Press* and *hold* to bypass the squelch and listen to channel activity.
4. **Belt Clip**
5. **Battery Compartment**
6. **Speaker**
7. **Microphone**
8. **Call Button** : *Press* this button to send a ringing sound to other radios tuned to the same channel.
9. **Up Button** : *Press* this button to increase the volume or channel setting or function selection.
10. **Down Button** : *Press* this button to decrease the volume or channel setting or function selection.
11. **LED Lamp** : Illuminates red when transmitting or, flashing when the battery power is low.
12. **Channel Select Switch** : This button to change the channel setting
13. **Antenna** : Rotate counterclockwise when transceiver is in use
14. **Microphone/Charger Jack** : For use with an external microphone / PTT button and optional battery charger
15. **Speaker Jack** : For use with an Audiovox approved headset accessory only.

◆ FUNCTION AND LOCATION OF THE CONTROLS

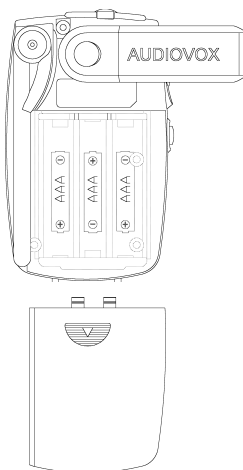


◆ WARNING

- Remove the batteries from the transceiver if it is not expected to be used for long periods. This will eliminate the possibility of battery acid leaking from the batteries and corroding the transceiver.
- Avoid exposing the unit to water or extremes of temperature.
- Do not use device in or near a mining facility, which uses remotely triggered explosives or in areas labeled "Blasting Area." Premature or accidental detonation may result.
- Do not attempt to modify or in any way increase the output of this transceiver. Its output is designed to meet the legal limits set by the FCC.
- Do not use this device or charge its batteries in potentially explosive atmospheres as sparks in such areas could result in an explosion.
- Turn your transceiver off wherever posted notices restrict the use of radio or cellular telephones. Facilities such as hospitals may use equipment that is sensitive to RF energy.

◆ BATTERY INSTALLATION

Your **FR500-2** requires three “AAA” alkaline cells or three rechargeable “AAA” cells. Alkaline batteries will provide the best performance from your transceiver. Remove the battery cover by rotating the belt clip away from the battery compartment. Slide the battery cover downward while applying pressure at the its grooved section. Observe the polarity symbols inside the battery tray when installing the batteries.



CAUTION:

- Incorrect battery installation can damage the unit.
- The microphone / charger jack is intended for use with Audiovox approved charging accessories only. Refer to the documentation included with the battery charger.
- Never attempt to charge alkaline batteries with the optional battery charger.

◆ OPERATION

Turning the Unit ON

Press and hold the power button.

Turning the Unit OFF

Press and hold the power button.

Adjusting the Speaker Volume

- ▶ Press the UP (▲) button to increase volume.
- ▶ Press the DOWN (▼) button to decrease volume.
- ▶ The LCD displays volume level on lower right corner by the number of bars.

◆ OPERATION

Transmitting a Signal

1. Push and hold the PTT button to transmit. The TX/BATT. LED will light up in red.
2. While holding the PTT button, speak in a normal voice about 2 to 3 inches away from the microphone.
3. Release the PTT button when you have finished transmitting.

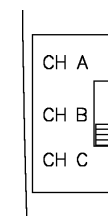
NOTE : In order for other people to receive your transmission, they must also be on the same channel you are current using. Refer to the “Changing Channels” section for more information.

Changing Channels

FR500-2 has 3 available channels.

To change channel :

1. Push switch to the top = CH A
 2. Push switch to the middle = CH B
 3. Push switch to the bottom = CH C
- ▶ The channel changes from A to B, or from B to A, repeatedly.

Monitor

You can use the MONITOR feature to check for weak signals in the current channel.

- ▶ Press and hold the MONITOR button till it beeps. MONITOR works continuously until released-pressed MONITOR again .
- ▶ Press the MONITOR button for channel skipping during SCAN mode.
