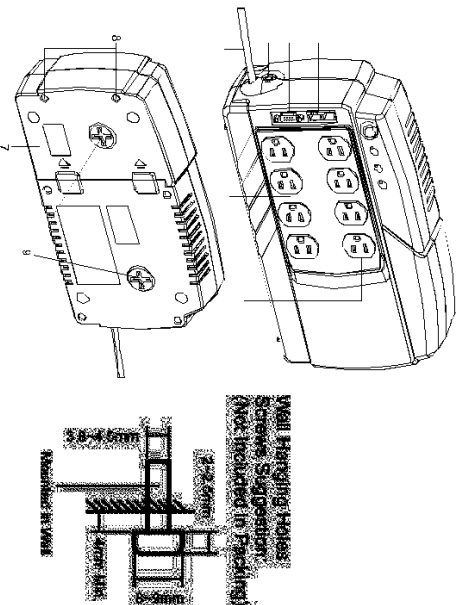


Rear Panel Explanation



1. **Computer Interface** : True RS232 Communication Protocol
2. **Backup Outlets** (4pcs NEMA5-15R)
3. **Line Outlets** (4pcs NEMA5-15R)
4. **Modem/LAN RJ-45 Jack (DATA ONLY)**
5. **AC Inlet**
6. **NFB** (No Fuse Breaker)
7. **Battery Cover**
8. **Battery Cover Screws**
9. **Wall Hanging Holes**

2. Line Connection

First, connect the UPS with the AC Mains to recharge internal battery for over 12 hours.(Please proceed charge process upon receipt.After more than 12 hours in charging, connect the line of your computer with the sockets of the UPS.)
3. Operation Test

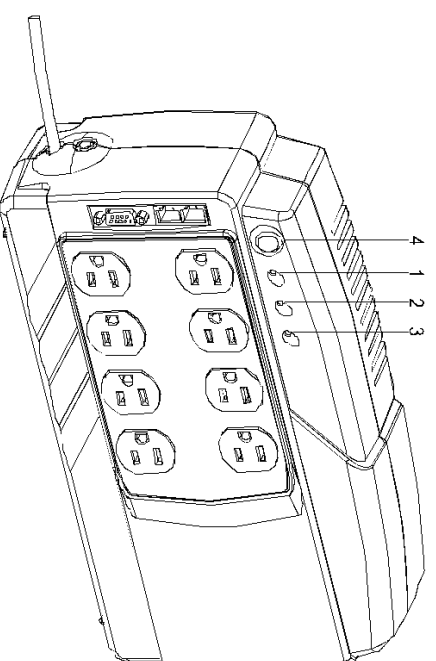
Connect the UPS to the wall receptacle.

- a.Push on the Main Switch to check the Green Line() Led is on.
- b.Connect your computer equipment with sockets of the UPS and pull off Power Cable of the UPS from the wall receptacle to check if Alarm buzzer is beeping.
- c.Try the field working condition by running some application programs on your computer and repeating step.
- d.Check if the UPS is initiated properly to support continuous operation.

INTRODUCING THE FRONT PANEL AND REAR PANEL AND ADDITIONAL PARTS

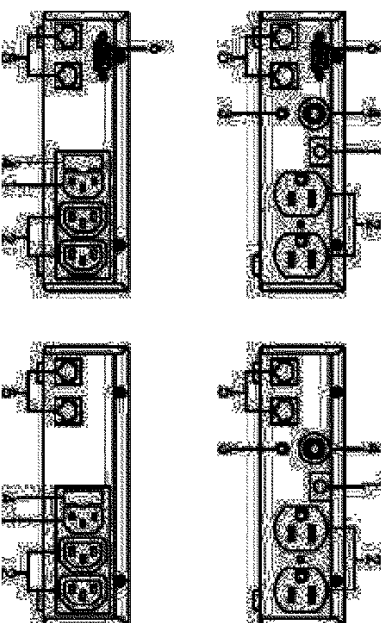
Front Panel Explanation



- 1.**Check Battery LED () :**
Red LED lights up when Battery Low or Fault.
2. **Line LED () :**
Green LED remains at a standstill when Utility Normal (Utility Fail alarm buzzer beeps)
3. **Site Wiring Fault LED ()**
- 4.**Main Switch () :**
 - a. To Control on/off the UPS when Utility is normal.
 - b. To enable "DC-Start" Function when Utility fails.

P.S. Make sure the computer connected to the UPS is switched on before enable the "DC-Start" function .You are not recommended to add some other computer or peripherals after DC-Start function is activated.

1. AC Inlet
2. Backup Outlets : 2pcs NEMA5-15R or IEC320
3. Site Wiring Fault Indicator :
4. NFB (NO Fuse Breaker) or FUSE
5. Modem/LAN RJ45 Jack (DATA ONLY)
6. Communication Interface

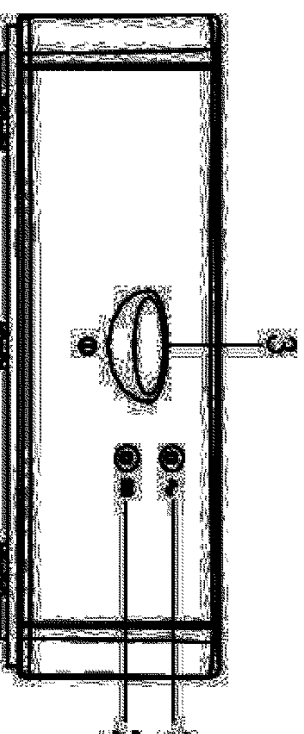

INTRODUCING THE FRONT PANEL AND REAR PANEL AND ADDITIONAL PARTS

Front Panel Explanation



1. Line () :

Green LED remains at a standstill when Utility Normal.
(When Utility Fails, alarm buzzer beeps continuously)

2. Check Battery() :

Red LED lights up when Battery Low or fault.

3. Main Switch :

a. To Control on/off the UPS when Utility is normal.

b. To enable "DC-Star" Function when Utility fails.

P.S. Make sure the computer connected to the UPS is switched on before enable the "DC-Star" function. You are not recommended to add some other computer or peripherals after "DC-Star" function is activated.
