









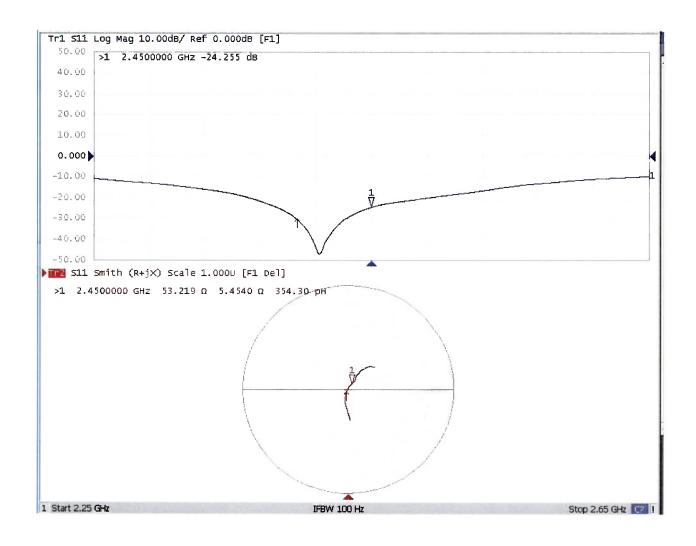

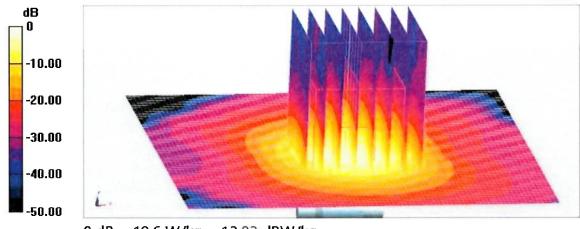

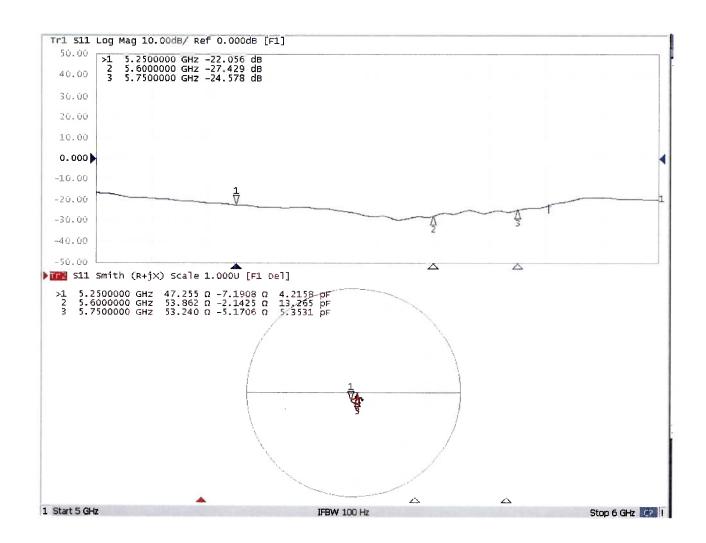







f=1800 MHz, R22






Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ±1.2% (k=2)






f=750 MHz,WGLS R9(H_convF)
