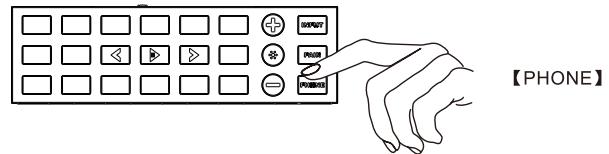
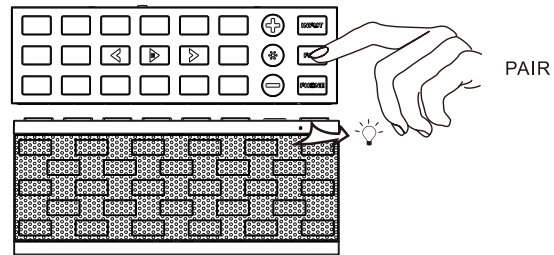


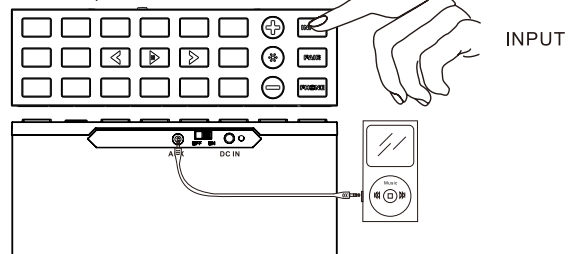
5. Speaker Phone operation: When the call comes in during playing music, answer the call by touching the button 【PHONE】 on the touching panel and talk facing the top panel; or dial the receiver button on the mobile to use mobile to answer the call.



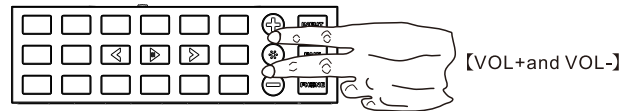
- 6.Re-pairing: To touch the PAIR button on the control panel for re-pairing, meanwhile the indicator will flash, and there is voice prompt"pairing". Please follow step 3 to do pairing.



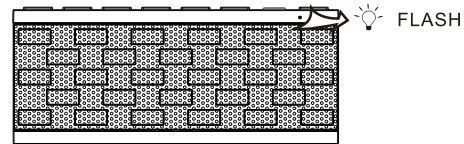
- 7.AUX input play: Switch the M3 on, touch the INPUT button on the control panel, the indicator will turn red, and the unit will be connected to the AUX channel play. The music in mobiles, MP3, PC, etc can be played through 3.5mm audio cable. You can adjust Volume by touch the VOL+ and VOL- on the control panel.



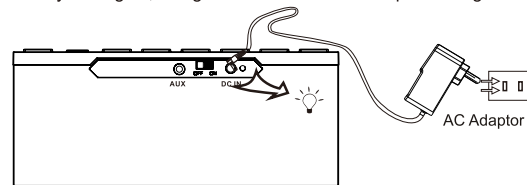
- 8.Turn off touch panel: Press and hold 【VOL+and VOL-】 in same time for 3 second, M3 will Turn off the touch button, except the Phone, the indicator light will turn red. Press and hold 【VOL+and VOL-】 in same time for 3 second to Turn on the touch panel.



- 9.Built-in battery : when using the built-in battery to play music, the unit will manage the battery use automatically, when the power is low, the unit will decrease the volume to ensure the sound quality and longer play time; when the power is not enough to support normal play, the indicator will flash 30 seconds and the unit will be switch to standby, please use the proper power adaptor to charge the unit for normal use



- 10.Charging:please use the supplied power adaptor to charging, the green indicator on the back of the unit will be flashing during charging. When the battery is fully-charged, the green indicator will stop flashing.



#### \* NOTE

- 1.The Bluetooth device can't find the speaker, the speaker may still connect with last Blue tooth device or another device are searching and connecting with speaker at same time. Now you need to operate as Step 6 to re-connect it.
- 2.If you hear intermittent sound or no sound from speaker after connection, please check if the distance from you and speaker are over 8-10M

- 3.Don't let Opposite close to speaker when you use speaker phone function to avoid Echo
- 4.Please use default music player with your blue tooth device system like, iPod, Samsung player, Windows media player. As lots of third party music player does not support smooth song change function, to avoid "pu" sound
5. Some of music player software can not support play pause, preview and next
- 6.Please use power adaptor which provide from Lanchiya to avoid damage your speaker
- 7.if your mobile doesn't support mobile ring transfer, you can only hear the M1 Built in ring voice " incoming call", when calling come in.

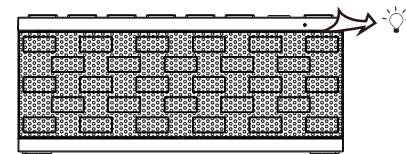


## Brief Operation Introduction

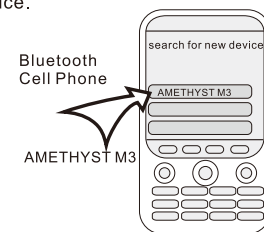
1. **Connection:** Switch M3 off, and connect it to AC power; or use with the built in battery. After that, switch it on.



2. **Power-on Operation:** After switching M3 on, the indicate light on the front panel is on, and the voice prompt "Power ON" and M3 is defaulted as the Bluetooth channel; then starts to search the device that connected last time. If the searching is successful, M3 will connect automatically with the device, and voices *prompt* "Du..". M3 will play the music through the device. If the searching is failed, M3 will be in the status of being searched by other devices.



3. **Connecting to the Bluetooth device:** Press "Pair" on the top of M3, the indicate light is on, and voice prompt "pair" Search and connect [AMETHYST M3] with your Bluetooth device.. The Invoice Prompt "pairing completed" then connected and voice prompt "DU...". Then you can play music from your Bluetooth device.



4. **Music-playing operation:** When M3 has successfully connected to the Bluetooth device properly, you can control the music-playing of the mobiles through touching the PRE,NEXT,PLAY/PAUSE button on the touching panel.
